Mentors are community members who are willing to invest in the lives of others.

Each Mentor will be matched with one participant while the participant is still incarcerated and continue meeting weekly once the participant is released from the Centre County Correctional Facility.

Participants are local individuals who are or have been incarcerated at the Centre County Correctional Facility. At the time the match is made the participant will be up to 90 days pre-release. They will begin meeting weekly with their Mentor at the facility and continue meeting in the community once released.

The Mentor Coordinators are here to offer support to both the Mentors and the Participants as they begin to build relationships with each other. Mentor Coordinators will check in regularly to make sure matches are feeling safe and confident, meeting up consistently, and to offer resources and ideas.
