

Code of Conduct

A fair, ethical and independent Office of Attorney General is essential to the administration of justice. Citizens have a right to trust in a legal system in which public officials and public employees maintain the highest standards of integrity and professionalism in discharging their duties as public servants. Every employee of the Office of Attorney General, therefore, shall observe the following standards of professional conduct to ensure the integrity of the Office of Attorney General at all times, including:

- Serving the interests of the Citizens of Pennsylvania above his/her own;
- Serving as a public employee with integrity, trustworthiness and professionalism;
- Carrying out their duties and directives without discrimination, without partiality, and without demonstrating or articulating insensitivity to race, color, religion, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, pregnancy, national origin, age, ancestry, disability or genetic information;
- Safeguarding all confidential information;
- Abiding by the formal policies, procedures and applicable collective bargaining agreements of the Office of Attorney General;
- Complying with all training including, but not limited to, professional certifications, ethics, and human resources requirements.

In signing below, I affirm this Code of Conduct of the Office of Attorney General and I will proudly discharge my duties with fidelity. In doing so, I recommit myself to the principle that public service is a public trust.
