- 2. The statement contains false, incomplete, or misleading information;
- 3. The information is material; and

(The term "material" means that the information is essential, that it has a logical connection to the facts, and that knowledge of that information would affect a person's view of the situation)

4. The statement is made with the intent to defraud an insurer.
