

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Affiant, Special Agent Brittany E. Lauck is assigned to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General's Child Predator Unit. SA Lauck is also assigned to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force which is comprised of Federal, State, and Local Law Enforcement. The task force is responsible for conducting undercover online investigations, responding to complaints regarding children sexually exploited via the Internet, conducting community education programs and monitoring of the Internet for the bartering in child pornography. SA Lauck has been investigating Internet Crimes against Children since February of 2014. Before being employed as a Special Agent with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, SA Lauck was employed as a Special Investigator at the Pennsylvania Office of Inspector General, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, from September of 2011 through February of 2014. SA Lauck has attended multiple training courses that focused on Internet Crimes Against Children, including computer-based offenses.

Parts of your Affiant's duties include investigating violations of state law, such as the online exploitation of children. In particular, violations of Title 18, Section 6312, that criminalizes the possession, receipt, and transmission of child pornography. Your Affiant has gained experience conducting such investigations through training seminars, classes and consistent work assignments.

Computer/Internet and Pornography Definitions:

The following are definitions and terms related to computers, the Internet, and this investigation.

Internet Protocol (IP) Number:

IP Numbers are a unique set of numbers consisting of 4 parts separated by dots, e.g., 165.113.245.2. This is used to identify devices on the Internet/Network. Every machine that is on the Internet has a unique IP number which can be used to track the location of a device. IP numbers are globally unique numeric identifiers that computers use to identify hosts and networks connected to the Internet.

American Registry of Internet Numbers (ARIN):

ARIN is a nonprofit organization that manages the IP Number resources throughout the Internet for North America, a portion of the Caribbean and sub-equatorial Africa. This free resource is used to determine the Internet Service Provider (ISP) for a specific IP number. Other registry organizations are responsible for registering and maintaining domain names, which are commonly, used unique identifiers that are translated into numeric addresses (IP numbers). IP numbers are globally unique, numeric identifiers that computers use to identify hosts and networks connected to the Internet. A free public database lookup is available from their website located at <http://www.arin.net>. This database can be searched to determine who an I.P. address is assigned. This is usually a large business or an Internet Service Provider (ISP).

Child Pornography:

"Child Pornography" - any book, magazine, pamphlet, slide, photograph, film, videotape, computer depiction or other material depicting a child under the age of 18 engaged in a prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of such act.

Prohibited Sexual Act:

Prohibited sexual act (as used in section 6312 of the PA Crimes Code) - sexual intercourse, masturbation, sadism, masochism, bestiality, fellatio, cunnilingus, lewd exhibition of the genitals or nudity if such nudity is depicted for the purpose of sexual stimulation or gratification of any person who might view that depiction.

Client User Hash:

Each client generates a 16-byte identifier to uniquely identify itself, referred to as the user hash. This unique value could be compared to a serial number. It is used on this file sharing network to identify itself with other clients to received credit for sharing files with users on the eDonkey2000/Kademlia Network.



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Skype:

Skype is software that enables individuals and businesses to make free video and voice one-to-one and group calls, send instant messages and share files with other people on Skype. Skype can be used on an individual's mobile device, computer or tablet. Skype is owned by Microsoft.

Probable Cause and Investigation Background

On April 6, 2017, Special Agent (SA) Megan Miller received a CyberTipline Report from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC), CyberTip #18225881.

SA Megan E. Miller is assigned to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General's Child Predator Unit. SA Miller is also assigned to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force which is comprised of Federal, State, and Local Law Enforcement. SA Miller has been investigating Internet Crimes against Children since January of 2016. SA Miller has attended multiple training courses that focused on Internet Crimes against Children, including computer-based offenses.

On February 28, 2017, Microsoft-SBO (Skype) reported the above Cybertip. Microsoft-SBO (Skype) reported a user that allegedly uploaded one file that contained Apparent Child Pornography. Microsoft-SBO (Skype) provided the following information regarding the User or Person Being Reported; Screen/User Name: live: 762e08e54c4d4ac and IP Address: 174.140.127.184. Microsoft-SBO (Skype) also provided the following information regarding the uploaded file: Filename: 71c50eca-e360-403c-9952-43088faab06c.jpg. Microsoft-SBO (Skype) provided the incident time at 02-27-2017 at 07:55:56 UTC. Microsoft-SBO (Skype) further stated that the ESP viewed the contents of the uploaded file in its entirety.

Description: The image depicts a Caucasian prepubescent minor male with dark hair. The minor male is naked, straddling a naked Caucasian male. The image shows the male's penis inserted into the anus of the prepubescent minor male. The prepubescent minor male is facing the camera; his face and penis are fully exposed.

SA Miller viewed the above file and confirmed the file appears to depict children, under the age of eighteen (18) years old engaged in sexual acts and/or pose, and is believed to be child pornography in violation of Pennsylvania Crimes Code Section 6312-Sexual Abuse of Children.

On April 7, 2017, SA Miller conducted a query on the IP address 174.140.127.184 through the American Registry for Internet Service Number (ARIN). SA Miller determined that the IP address, 174.140.127.184, is registered to Atlantic Broadband.

SA Miller completed administrative subpoena (#01020) for Atlantic Broadband to provide the subscriber information for the IP address 174.140.127.184 on February 27, 2017 at 07:55:56 UTC. Senior Deputy Attorney General (SDAG) Christopher Jones reviewed the administrative subpoena and signed it. On April 7, 2017, SA Miller sent the administrative subpoena to Atlantic Broadband.

SA Miller also completed administrative subpoena (#01021) for Microsoft to provide the subscriber information for Skype User: live: 762e08e54c4d4ac. SDAG Jones reviewed the administrative subpoenas and signed them. On April 7, 2017, SA Miller sent the administrative subpoena to Microsoft.

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On April 7, 2017, SA Miller received a response from Atlantic Broadband for subpoena 01020, which provided the following information as the subscriber for the IP address 174.140.127.184 on February 27, 2017 at 07:55:56 UTC:

Atlantic Broadband also provided payment information. According to Atlantic Broadband this account is paid by a bill pay service called Metavante.

A query was also conducted within the Pennsylvania Justice Network (JNET) portal to determine whether the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) had any driver demographic information pertaining to the aforementioned individual subscriber or address. JNET is a secure database in which access is limited and restricted to individuals or entities with appropriate law enforcement or social service credentials. PennDOT had driver demographic information for the individual Robert B Beck whose driver's license was last issued on 03/11/2015, is current, and lists 517 N 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601, as his address. PennDot also provided three other individuals residing at the above address; Rebecca S. Beck whose driver's license was last issued on 9/20/13 and is current, Bradley Blair Beck whose driver's license was last issued on 08/09/2014 and a female juvenile.

On April 10, 2017, SA Miller and Your Affiant conducted surveillance at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601. This residence is a yellow two story single family home. The house number can be found to the right of the front door. The front door has a screen door. There is parking in the rear of the house on an alley, and there is a possible detached garage. An F150 was parked in the rear of the house with a vanity license plate that said "Fisher and Beck Builders". The back yard is fenced in and there is a dog at the residence. The wireless internet connection found was locked. There also appears to be a rear porch with a back door. Several wireless internet connections were found at the residence. All connections were secure with the exception of "BBeck-guest".

On July 21, 2017, all information for this case was transferred to Your Affiant for further investigation.

**POLICE CRIMINAL COMPLAINT**

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On July 31, 2017, your Affiant viewed the one (1) aforementioned image [71c50eca-e360-403c-9952-43088faab06c.jpg] which was reported and confirmed that the image depicted children, under the age of eighteen (18) years old engaged in sexual acts and/or pose, and is believed to be child pornography in violation of Pennsylvania Crimes Code Section 6312-Sexual Abuse of Children.

On February 27, 2018, Your Affiant contacted United States Postal Inspector, Michael Corricelli for his assistance in verifying who receives mail at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601, Blair County.

Your Affiant spoke with Inspector Corricelli and asked for his assistance in verifying who receives mail at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601, Blair County. According to a Postal Service representative of the United States Postal Inspection Service, USPIS, advised that Robert and Rebecca Beck continue to receive mail at that address. The representative also indicated potential children in the home. The Change of Address System (COARS) indicated no change for the residence.

Additionally, a Postal Service representative stated that the residence has a large dog.

Your Affiant knows from her training and experience that multiple electronic devices can be used to download the Skype application. Furthermore, multiple electronic devices can then be used to log into a Skype account in order to upload, view, or share electronic data. It was believed and therefore averred that the electronic devices located within the residence located at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601 contained evidence of the utilization of the aforementioned Skype account pertaining to this investigation.

On March 5, 2018, Your Affiant obtained a search warrant for 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601, Blair County.

On March 5, 2018, agents from the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General executed a search warrant at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601, Blair County. At approximately 1015 HRS, agents and officers from the Altoona Police Department knocked on the front door of the residence, in which Robert Beck opened the door. Your Affiant explained to Robert Beck that the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General's Office had a search warrant for the residence. Robert Beck stepped outside the residence, and agents entered. Robert Beck indicated that he lives at the residence with his wife, Rebecca Beck, son, Bradley Beck, and his daughter (17 years of age). Robert Beck indicated that Bradley Beck was presently at the residence. Bradley Beck was located on the second-floor bathroom of the residence. Agents located a cell phone on Bradley Beck's person. Bradley Beck provided agents with the password to the cell phone.

Special Agent Travis Nye and Your Affiant spoke to Bradley Beck (Beck) in the first bedroom on the left, on the second floor of the residence, which was identified as Room "E". At approximately 1019 HRS, your Affiant advised Beck of his Miranda rights, which he understood. Beck reviewed a paper copy of the Miranda rights, which he read and agreed to speak with Agents without an attorney present. Beck also agreed to have the conversation audio recorded.

Beck stated that he resides at 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601 with his mother and father, and minor sister. Beck indicated he has lived at the residence his entire life. Beck further explained that no one stayed for any prolonged period of time, other than his Grandparents. Beck explained to agents that he resides on the third floor of the residence. Beck's bedroom is identified as room "G."

Beck indicated that there are several electronics within the home. Beck indicated that he has a laptop computer, which is located in the closet in Room G, [Beck's bedroom.] Beck also indicated that he has a cell phone, which is password protected. Beck explained that he provided agents with the password on his cell phone. Beck indicated that there is a desktop computer and a laptop located on the first floor of the residence, however, he does not utilize them. Beck also stated that he has an Xbox gaming console in his room.

Beck explained that he uses internet service at the house, which is provided by Atlantic Broadband. Beck stated that the internet is wireless, however, is locked, requiring a password is required to utilize it [the internet]. Beck indicated the names of the wireless signals were "BBeck." Your affiant reviewed the wireless signals available and located "BBeck" and verified the signal was locked. Beck never gave the internet password to anyone other than family members or friends, while at the house.

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Beck explained that he uses his phone mostly for the internet. Beck explained that he has several social media applications (apps) including Skype. Beck explained that the Skype app was only on his cell phone. Beck indicated that he last utilized the Skype app was January 2017.

Your Affiant explained to Beck that Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General was conducting an investigation involving child pornography, which resolved back to 517 N. 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16601.

Beck admitted, "it was me." Beck further identified the aforementioned image [71c50eca-e360-403c-9952-43088faab06c.jpg] as an image in which he uploaded to Skype. Beck indicated that he was Skype video chatting with a friend, and while chatting, uploaded the aforementioned image of child pornography.

Beck then explained that there are images on his cell phone. Beck explained that he takes picture of minors without their knowledge. Beck indicated the last time he took pictures of a minor was as recently as last week. Beck told agents that the images were of full-clothed children and were not "demeaning." Beck was asked if he ever touched any of the children that he took pictures of. Beck stated no.

Agents asked Beck if he knew any of the children he [Beck] took pictures of. Beck admitted that he knew one boy, identified as "CR" (8 years of age). Beck stated that he frequently would pick CR up from school and watch him and CR's younger brother, BR, until their mother arrived home from work. Beck stated that he never touched CR in a sexual manner. Beck further explained that it "took all he had" to not touch him.

Agents located boys underwear in Beck's bedroom (Room G). Beck explained that at least one of the pairs of underwear located were a pair of CR's underwear. Beck stated that while at CR's house, he saw the underwear laying out and took them. Beck admitted that he has worn CR's underwear.

Beck stated that he does not save images and videos of child pornography to any external hard drives, disks, or thumb drives.

Special Agent, David Middendorf and Special Agent Matt Zahm of the Computer Forensics Unit assisted with on scene with previews of the electronic storage devices located within the home. In a preview of Beck's Apple iPhone, Special Agent Middendorf located at least 16 images of apparent child pornography. Additionally, Special Agent Middendorf located a video of apparent child pornography. Special Agent Middendorf indicated that the images and video appear to be child pornographic images/videos that were produced on Beck's Apple iPhone.

Special Agent Nye and Your Affiant then spoke to Beck with the information found by Special Agent Middendorf. Beck became visibly upset and stated the he had forgot about that video. Beck explained the video, to which CR is sitting on Beck's lap, and Beck's hand is down CR's underwear, and appears to be masturbating CR. Beck admitted to capturing the video on his cell phone while masturbating CR. Additionally, nude images of BR were located on Beck's cell phone.

All electronic items were transported to the Computer Forensics Unit's secured evidence room until a complete forensic analysis of the items can be completed.

Based on the information listed above, your Affiant requests an arrest warrant be issued for Bradley Blair Beck.
