Section Description:	The Antitrust Section helps protect the free enterprise system by detecting anticompetitive practices and taking legal action to stop them. The Section brings legal actions to recover overcharges paid by consumers and state agencies as the result of violations of state and federal antitrust laws. The Section also reviews and challenges mergers which may result in consumers or state agencies paying higher prices or which will harm Pennsylvania's economy. The Antitrust Section also handles miscellaneous complex litigation not handled by other sections.
