We are the Solicitor for Carroll Township, Perry County. This responds to your letter of July 24, 2019 in regard to a request you received from [REDACTED]. I am responding to your letter on behalf of the Township.

[REDACTED] submitted a conditional use application to the Board of Supervisors, Carroll Township, under the Carroll Township zoning ordinance for a commercial/retail/farm market and bakery for property located in the Township. A second page for that application indicated for use as a food store and a second application was subsequently submitted for a use on the property identified as a food/retail store. The Board of Supervisors held a hearing on that application on January 11, 2019 and issued a written decision under date of February 12, 2019 denying the application. A land use appeal was filed by the Applicant on March 13, 2019, copy attached, and the Township filed the Certified Record with the Court. On June 27, 2019, the Applicant withdrew the land use appeal, copy attached. A copy of the certified record is included with this letter. If anything else is needed, please advise.
