To Whom it may concern,

I am a forester for [REDACTED] We recently purchased a tract of timber in Dilliner PA, which is in Dunkard Township located in Greene County.
I contacted Dunkard Township to bond two roads to haul logs. I agreed to bond Cemetery Hill Road for .55 miles and Williamson Hill Road for 1.07 miles at the rate of \$12,500.00 per mile. Dunkard Township then sent me a heavy hauling agreement. I believe that there are nonreturnable fees in this agreement that are unacceptable. They are wanting to charge us a nonreturnable fee of \$3,500 per road as a usage fee. Which would be a cost of \$7,000.00 just to use these two roads. They are also wanting to charge us \$375.00 per road as a permit fee. Basically they are wanting \$7,750.00 in fees plus the road bond of \$20,500.00 to use these roads. I am attaching a copy of the heavy hauling agreement, Engineer weight limit study and also a copy of their ordinance for you to review. Located on page 9 section 18 of this agreement you will find the paragraph requesting these fees.

It is my understanding that with the ACRE law these fees should not be required for timber removal. Any help you can give me with this matter would be truly appreciated.
