Section Description: The Gun Violence Section investigates and prosecutes firearm

trafficking, straw purchase of firearms, the movement of illegal guns, and violent gun crime. In addition to firearms violations, the GVS investigates and prosecutes cases where firearms are used in violent crimes throughout Philadelphia. In partnership with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies, the Gun Violence Task Force has been able to arrest individuals responsible for murders, shootings, and

gunpoint robberies.
