#### AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiants for this arrest warrant are Pennsylvania State Troopers. Corporal Kyle Tobin and Trooper Trisha Campbell are both currently assigned to the Pennsylvania State Police, Newport Station, Criminal Investigation Unit. Your affiants have been so employed for a combined total of twenty-five years, with over ten years' experience as criminal investigators. Both affiants have extensive experience as well as training in criminal investigation. Your affiants have successfully investigated and arrested over one hundred persons for violations of criminal law in Pennsylvania, including a variety of sex crimes involving children. Both affiants have conducted successful investigations that have led to the arrest and prosecution of offenders for major crimes to include Rape, Sexual Assault, Murder / Criminal Homicide. The facts set forth in this affidavit are true and correct to the best of each affiant's knowledge and belief.

The initial complaint originated in 2015 as it was reported the Judge Michael SCHECHTERLY had young boys spending the night at his Magisterial District Court Office located at 133 S. 5<sup>th</sup> St, Newport Borough, Perry County. Through the course of that investigation it was discovered that Judge SCHECHTERLY had four (4) young boys spending the night at his office on 8/12/15 from 2150 hour until the next morning at 0700 hours. It was also reported that Judge SCHECHTERLY had pornographic videos in his office. Search warrants were obtained for Judge SCHECHTERLY's office and personal residence also located in Newport Borough. Notable videos depicted young females engaged in BDSM type sexual activity and appeared as being sexually assaulted or abused was found on DVD's in the Judge's Office. Additionally, surveillance video was obtained and material concerning Royal Rangers was found in Judge SCHECHTERLY's office desk. In consultation with the Perry County District Attorney's Office no charges were filed at that time.

However, on 3/2/19 the Pennsylvania State Police at Newport again received information from the Perry County District Attorney's Office that initiated a criminal investigation into Judge Michael SCHECHTERLY

having inappropriate contact with minor children at his Newport Borough residence and district court office. The District Attorney's office had received a complaint from a William BENNER.

William BENNER was interviewed in reference to this investigation and stated that he had suspicions that a child with special needs identifies as K.C.K. has possibly had inappropriate contact with Judge Michael SCHECHTERLY. William BENNER stated that he knew the child well and that on one instance the child had disclosed concerning behavior by Judge Michael SCHECHTERLY to him. William BENNER stated that he thought the matter needed to be investigated further by the state police and that is why he forwarded the information to the Perry County District Attorney's Office.

When asked what the concerning behavior about Judge SCHECHTERLY, BENNER stated that K.C.K. made an unprovoked statement "he is a weird guy," when talking about Judge SCHECHTERLY. BENNER further stated that K.C.K. then stated that while in Royal Rangers, SCHECHTERLY would walk around his house in his underwear, and was scratching his balls. BENNER stated that K.C.K. then stated that he told him to stop, but SCHECHTERLY kept walking and scratching.

On 4/11/19, a forensic interview was conducted at the Children's Resource Center in Harrisburg, PA by a child interview specialist. The interview was audibly and visually recorded. During that interview K.C.K. did relate that one time he saw SCHECHTERLY laying in his underwear scratching his "balls," while at SCHECHTERLY's residence. No action was taken at that time.

On 5/28/20 Pennsylvania State Police at Newport became aware of additional concerns regarding SCHECHTERLY'S ongoing contact with minors. It was determined that in addition to the previously complaints of alleged inappropriate contact and concerns regarding children having sleepovers at Judge SCHECHTERLY's office, Judge SCHECHETELY had continued to bring children to his office during the COVID-19 shut down in the early Spring of 2020.

An interview was conducted with Judge SCHECHTERLY's secretary Jamie YORK who observed two young boys at the office and became alarmed as he followed one of the boys to the bathroom and significant amount of time passed prior to returning. YORK had gone to check on the boy but met Judge SCHECHTERLY and the boy in the hallway returning from the bathroom. YORK could not identify the boys. It was learned, in this investigation, that these boys were also having sleepovers at SCHECHTERLY's residence. It was determined that these boys were not related to SCHECHTERLY.

In cooperation with the Perry County District Attorney's Office, a search warrant was obtained for the surveillance video operating in Judge SCHECHTERLY's office. On 06/03/20 at approximately 2245 hours, the search warrant was executed at 133 South 5th Street, Newport Borough for the video surveillance. Through this surveillance, it was learned that Judge SCHECHTERLY had children at his District Court Office, that are not his own nor are they of relation to SCHECHTERLY. This was outside of normal operating hours while

no other adults were present. Judge SCHECHTERLY was found not to be conducting district court duties during these times. One of the videos observed, showed Judge SCHECHTERLY holding two male children under 10 years of age on his lap. This same video showed the one male child making attempts to remove himself from Judge SCHECHTERLY's lap while being prevented from doing so by SCHECHTERLY.

The children observed on SCHECHTERLY's lap and other videos were identified and interviewed at the Children's Resource Center in Harrisburg, PA.

On or about 6/25/20, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General assumed jurisdiction of this matter due to SHECHTERLY'S role as a state employee and to avoid any appearance of conflict on the part of the Perry County District Attorney's Office.

On 6/30/20, Judge Michael SCHECHTERLY was interviewed at the Pennsylvania State Police Newport Station in reference to this investigation. Judge SCHECHTERLY is known to the Pennsylvania State Police as the Magisterial District Judge for District Court 41-3-04. SCHECHTERLY is known as "Commander Mike" as the Royal Ranger Leader in his church at Newport Assembly of God. SCHECHTERLY is also the Sectional Royal Ranger Commander, covering six counties in Pennsylvania and is part of the Penn-Del District. Prior to becoming the District Judge, SCHECHTERLY taught school for three years in Halifax, one year as a long-term substitute and approximately eight years at what was Perry Christian Academy. After teaching, SCHECHTERLY attended law school and became a defense attorney prior to running for Magisterial District Judge.

During this interview, SCHECHTERLY initially denied that he had juvenile males sleeping over at the district justice office and later confirmed that juvenile males in the Royal Ranger Program did sleep over at the office.

SCHECHTERLY discussed his porn addiction during this interview and stated that the 2015 investigation was a wake-up call that he needed. SCHECHTERLY stated that he joined a local support group "Genesis" through his church and has not had the desire for porn or masturbation since this time. SCHECHTERLY stated some of the porn found in 2015 was Sadomasochism in addition to the regular porn. SCHECHTERLY admitted that he was consumed by it even affecting his time, thoughts and views on women. SCHECHTERLY discussed his masturbation habits, masturbating up to several times a day, to include self-induced bondage and regularly masturbating at the district court office. When question regarding stains on surfaces in the district court he indicated those stains would likely be his semen. In the course of this conversation SHECHTERLY admitted that as an adolescent he was sexually attracted to boys. SCHECHTERLY attributed this as normal for adolescent boys to be attracted to one another as "a natural stage of growth".

When confronted with C.R.C. interview of what K.C.K. observed with SCHECHTERLY's hand being in his pants, SCHECHTERLY indicated that he could not say he had never masturbated while a child was in his care or in his home.

SCHECHTERLY was asked if he has ever had sexual contact with a child. SCHECHTERLY stated that on one occasion he had a boy (approximately 12 years of age) at his house and he touched the boys crotch / groin area. SCHECHTERLY explained that the boy took his hand (SCHECHTERLY's hand) and put it on the child's crotch. SCHECHTERLY stated that he told the boy no and pulled his hand away. SCHECHTERLY then changed his story and stated that the boy took his own hand and placed it on SCHECHTERLY's crotch.

When questioned further SCHECHTERLY stated that the touching was not an accidental touch. When questioned about the identity of the boy SCHECHTERLY stated that he could not remember the boy's name but that he was 50% sure that it was K.C.K. or his older brother identified as K.K. K.K. was interviewed and denied any inappropriate behavior between himself and Judge SCHECHTERLY. K.K. stated that when Judge SCHECHTERLY stated that this touching of a child was either him or his brother K.C.K. that it had to be his younger brother K.C.K. SCHECHTERLY explained his inability to recall the specific child by stating that there have been so many boys it was difficult to recall.

On 10/8/20, K.C.K. was interviewed at the Pennsylvania State Police Newport Station in reference to this investigation. K.C.K. reiterated in this interview what he disclosed during his C.R.C. interview on 4/11/19. K.C.K. again described that he had gone to take a shower while spending the night at Judge SCHECHTERLY's residence. K.C.K. described when he came out of the shower and returned downstairs, he went into the living room where Judge SCHECHTERLY was on the couch. K.C.K. stated that he observed Judge SCHECHTERLY with his hand in his pants playing with himself / scratching himself. K.C.K. stated that SCHECHTERLY's hand was in his pants for approximately five (5) minutes.

During the initial portion of the interview K.C.K. was asked if he was ever touched in his genital area by Judge SCHECHTERLY or if he had ever touched Judge SCHECHTERLY in his genital area. K.C.K. stated that this had never happened.

K.C.K. was then shown a portion of the interview of Judge SCHECHTERLY on 6/30/20 when he admitted to the touching and named K.C.K. as the possible child that was involved. After being confronted with Judge SCHECHTERLY's admission to the touching, K.C.K. disclosed that when he and Judge SCHECHTERLY were sitting on the couch watching television. K.C.K. stated that Judge SCHECHTERLY reached over and placed his hand on K.C.K.'s privates. K.C.K.'s date of birth is 06/19/2000. He would have been 12 years old at the time of this assault.

Coupled with Judge SCHECHTERLY's admission and K.C.K.'s recollection of Judge SCHECHTERLY touching the genital area of K.C.K. an arrest warrant is being requested at this time for the accused Michael E. SCHECHTERLY.

Assistant Chief Deputy Attorney General Daniel J. Dye of the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General has reviewed the averments made within this affidavit and has approved the filing of the charges contained herein.
