AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

- 1. Your Affiant, Crystal J. Adames, is a sworn Narcotics Agent with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (OAG), Bureau of Narcotics Investigations and Drug Control (BNIDC). Your Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer for approximately (4) years and is currently assigned to OAG BN1 Region I, located in Allentown, PA, to investigate the illegal distribution of controlled substances. The BNIDC investigates and prosecutes violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code including, but not limited to, Title 35, the Pennsylvania Controlled Substance, Drug Device and Cosmetic Act of 1972.
- 2. Your Co-Affiant, Curtis Jones, is a sworn Narcotics Agent with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (OAG), Bureau of Narcotics Investigations and Drug Control (BNIDC). Your Co-Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer for approximately (3) years and is currently assigned to OAG BN1 Region II, located in Philadelphia, PA, to investigate the illegal distribution of controlled substances. The BNIDC investigates and prosecutes violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code including, but not limited to, Title 35, the Pennsylvania Controlled Substance, Drug Device and Cosmetic Act of 1972.
- 3. As part of an ongoing investigation into the methamphetamine distribution, your Affiants learned that Larry Lamar Hudson was obtaining significant quantities of methamphetamine and from an unknown source of supply. Additionally, it was determined that the defendant was selling quantities of methamphetamine in the Montgomery and Philadelphia County areas.
- 4. During the course of this investigation Affiant Adames has positively identified "LAMAR" or "GUNNA" as Larry Lamar HUDSON. Your Affiants accessed the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation JNET data base and obtained a driver's license photograph of Larry Lamar HUDSON. Your Affiants displayed the aforementioned photograph of HUDSON to the CI who positively identified the photograph as the individual he/she knows to sell quantities of methamphetamine in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Historically, the CI has been making weekly purchases or methamphetamine from HUDSON over six months and he/she pays \$5,600 per pound.
- 5. During the week of November 15, 2020, the CI spoke with Senior Deputy Attorney General Christie Bonesch at which time the CI was consentualized. The CI was authorized to intercept electronic and oral communications of clandestine meetings between the CI, Larry HUDSON and others who may be involved or identified throughout the course of this investigation for period of 30 days.
- 6. On the aforementioned date, Affiant Adames met with the CI intending to purchase a quantity of methamphetamine from HUDSON. Affiant Adames instructed the CI to call HUDSON on his cellular telephone, from a location in Lehigh County. Affiant Adames watched the CI dial the numbers (215) 298-1647 into his/her cellular telephone. During this conversation, the CI asked HUDSON if they could meet (referring to wanting to purchase (1) pound of methamphetamine from HUDSON). HUDSON agreed and the CI advised he/she would contact HUDSON once he/she was closer to determine a meet location.
- 7. A short time later HUDSON contacted the CI from cellular number (215) 298-1647 and instructed the CI to go to "his spot." The CI knows this to mean for him/her to go to HUDSON's residence located at 200 Sparks St. Philadelphia, PA.
- 8. The CI and their vehicle was searched for narcotics, weapons and contraband with negative results. The CI was directly followed from Lehigh County to a predetermined location in Philadelphia. The CI gave Affiant Adames an amount of US currency to hold. The CI was given prerecorded US currency, an amount known to Affiant Adames. Surveillance was already established at 200 Sparks St. At approximately 4:17 PM agents observed Hudson exit his residence with a white bag and place it in his red Ford Taurus bearing license plate LVK0909. Affiant Adames and another Agent followed the CI to the vicinity of 200 Sparks St. Upon arrival surveillance units observed Hudson

retrieve the white bag from the red Ford Taurus and subsequently enter the Cl's vehicle on the corner of Sparks and N. 2nd St. A brief time later Hudson exited the Cl's vehicle and walked directly to 200 Sparks St. and utilized a key to enter the residence.

- 9. The CI was followed to a predetermined location in Philadelphia, where he/she immediately relinquished one (1) pound of methamphetamine in a white bag. The CI and their vehicle was searched for narcotics, weapons and contraband with negative results. Your Affiant returned the CI's currency. The CI was debriefed and stated that Hudson entered his/her vehicle and exchanged the white bag with the methamphetamine for the prerecorded US currency. Your Affiant conducted a field test on a random sample of the suspected methamphetamine which produced a positive reaction. The methamphetamine was placed into evidence and will be submitted to the Pennsylvania State Police Crime Laboratory for further analysis.
- 10. On November 24, 2020 Affiant Adames prepared a pen register/trap and trace device for T-Mobile cellular telephone number (215) 298-1647 utilized by Lamar HUDSON. On the same date Assistant Chief Deputy Attorney General Melissa Francis prepared an application and order to accompany the affidavit and support of application for the disclosure of mobile communication tracking information and/or the installation and use of a pen register and trap and trace device for cellular telephone number (215) 298-1647. On the same date the application order were presented to and signed by Philadelphia Common Pleas Court Judge Ann Marie B. Coyle.
- 11. On December 2, 2020, Affiant Adames and another Agent met with the CI at a location in Berks County. During this meeting the CI placed a recorded phone call to Larry Hudson at phone number (215) 298-1647. At approximately 12:38 PM the CI made contact with Hudson and inquired about purchasing a ½ a pound of methamphetamine in the near future. Hudson responded "I'm going to have to pop it open" and agreed to selling the half a pound for \$2,500. The recorded phone call was retained by this agent and entered into BNI I Region I Evidence Inventory System.
- 12. On December 7, 2020 Affiant Adames and another Agent met with the CI at a prearranged location. During this meeting the CI placed a recorded phone call to Larry Hudson at number (215) 298-1647. The attempted phone call made was unsuccessful. He/She then texted Hudson to call him/her in which Hudson responded, "I'm at a meeting now." The CI then texted Hudson and asked him to call him/her. A short time later Hudson returned the phone call. During this recorded conversation the CI inquired about purchasing the ½ pound of methamphetamine previously discussed on December 2, 2020. Hudson told the CI he is "still in Maryland" and will be back in an about an hour. At the time of this phone call, surveillance units observed Hudson at a gas station located in Philadelphia. At approximately 2:15 PM this agent instructed the CI to text Hudson "Gunna head down your way." Hudson responded "I'm not going back until my stuff get here." The CI then asked "When will that be?" Hudson responded "I'm waiting on it nowl." The CI asked Hudson "well should I head your way? I'm just trying to save time. Hudson responded, "Not yet! I don't (want) you waiting."
- 13. On December 29, 2020, the CI spoke with Senior Deputy Attorney General Christie Bonesch at which time the CI was consentualized. The CI was authorized to intercept electronic and oral communications of clandestine meetings between the CI, Larry HUDSON and others who may be involved or identified throughout the course of this investigation for period of 30 days.
- 14. On January 12, 2021, information was developed indicating that the defendant, Larry L. Hudson was in possession of a large quantity of methamphetamine and was going to sell it. Your Affiants learned of the time and location of this methamphetamine sale with Montgomery County.
- 15. Surveillance was established at Hudson's residence located at 200 Spark St. Philadelphia, PA. The defendant was directly followed to Home Depot located at 7690 Washington Ln. Wyncote, PA 19095. Upon arrival, the defendant was taken into custody by BNI Agents without incident.

- 16. Hudson along with his vehicle were transported to Cheltenham Police Department. Agents were deployed at 200 Sparks St. to secure the perimeter of the property. Hudson was read his Miranda rights in which he waived and subsequently provided a verbal and written statement. Hudson explained to Agents that located inside his residence were (2) two to (3) three pounds of methamphetamine, approximately (8) firearms and approximately \$60,000 in US currency. He also stated that prior to being taken into custody he was on his way to sell (1) one pound of methamphetamine for \$4,700 which is located inside his red Ford Taurus bearing license plate LKV0909.
- 17. Your Affiants requested and received a lawfully signed search warrant approval for a the residence and the vehicle and the following items were located and seized:
 - a. one (1) pounds of crystal methamphetamine (in vehicle)
 - b. 2 long guns, 1 shot gun and 6 hands guns along with assorted ammo and magazines
 - c. 1 clear zip lock bag containing 14 one ounce clear plastic bags each containing crystal methamphetamine
 - d. 1 large clear bag containing 2 large one pound bulky packages wrapped in clear tape each containing crystal methamphetamine
 - e. 3 clear plastic bags containing a total of 102 greenish tinted plastic vials each containing crystal methamphetamine
 - f. 1 clear zip-lock bag contain a total of 431 packets of alleged heroin each stamped "New High Score Ultimate Level", approximately weight 13.7 grams
 - g. 4 large new unused vials of packaging material
 - h. USC- A total of \$56,585.00 found in the bedroom inside assorted shoe boxes.
- 18. A sample of the methamphetamine was field tested resulting in a positive reactions. The suspected heroin along with the methamphetamine will be submitted to the Pennsylvania State Police Crime Laboratory for further analysis.
