1. Your Affiant, Agent Roderick Jackson (NA Jackson), being duly sworn, deposes and says, I am Narcotics Agent employed by the Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control (OAG-BNI) assigned to the Gun Violence Section. As such, I am tasked with investigating violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code including Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act (18 Pa.C.S.A. § 6105, 6106), illegal firearm transfers and straw purchases (18 Pa.C.S.A. § 6111) and violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act of April 1972, P.L. 233, No. 64, 35 P.S. §780-101 et. seq., Corrupt Organizations (18 Pa. C.S.A. §911) and charges recommended by a statewide investigating grand jury. Your Affiant has participated in numerous illegal firearm trafficking, straw purchase investigations, narcotic investigations and related search and arrest warrants throughout the Commonwealth. I have received training from the Pennsylvania State Police that includes the Class "A" certification course for Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance conducted by the Pennsylvania State Police and Pennsylvania Attorney General. I am certified to employ such techniques while conducting criminal investigations, maintaining "A" certification number A-6142. Since obtaining the Class "A" certification, I have participated in consensual investigations. I am currently detailed to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Task Force as a federal task force officer and am tasked with investigating both state and federal violations relative to firearms trafficking, straw purchasing and felons in possession of firearms.

2. Your co-affiant, Detective Robert Renk of the Monroeville Police Department is a law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania within the meaning of section 5702, Title 18 Pa. C.S.A, and as such, I am empowered to make arrests for the criminal offenses enumerated in Title 18 and 35, PA C.S.A. I have been a Monroeville Police Officer since October of 2012 and have been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division since July 2014.

3. On Sunday, February 7, 2021, Officers from the Monroeville Police Department and Agents from the Office of Attorney General (PAOAG) were conducting a surveillance detail at the Monroeville Convention Center. This detail was the result of a recent increase in multiple straw purchases and thefts at prior Monroeville Showmasters gun shows. At approximately 1005 hours, I entered the men's rest room of the gun show and observed two males engaged in a hand to hand transfer of money. The males were later identified as David Fields and Earl Eggleton. Fields was observed counting large denominations of U.S. Currency and handing it to Eggleton. This transfer of money is common in the crime of straw purchasing; which is a violation of Pennsylvania Crime Code Title 18 Violation of Uniform Act Section 6111. I then departed the restroom area and notified Officers on the detail.

4. Surveillance of the two men was conducted within the main showroom of the convention center. Eggleton was observed running to the vendor Mischak Hunting Supplies located in the North portion of the show room. Upon Completing the sale, Eggleton took possession of a box later found to contain an IWI Pro Pistol 9mm SN:U1001768. Fields was observed carrying this box. Eggleton then went to the Trinity Armory Dealer. Eggleton then made a purchase of a Charles Daly Pak-9 Pistol SN: RON2024459. As he was exiting the South show room, Officers approached both men. Both men were escorted to an opened room. This Agent advised Earl Eggleton of his Miranda Rights. Eggleton stated that he understood his rights and signed the wavier form witnessed by Monroeville Lt. Bill Krut. Eggleton stated that he was willing to answer questions in regards to this incident.

5. On this date Eggleton stated he purchased two (2) firearms at the Showmasters Gun Show Convention Center. Eggleton admitted to smoking Marijuana at 0530am on this date. In doing that, Eggleton made a false statement on the Pennsylvania State Police Application Record of Sale. Eggleton falsified form 4473 question 21 (3) that asks "Are you an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana or any depressant, stimulant, narcotic, drug, or any other controlled substance for medicinal or recreational purposes in the state where you reside."

6. Agents furthered the investigation with Eggleton learning that he purchased two (2) additional pistols last Wednesday from Keystone Firearms in Cranberry. Eggleton was then asked how many firearms he owned in total. Eggleton stated that he owned approximately fifteen (15) firearms. Eggleton was asked if the firearms were located at his residence. Eggleton stated that some were at his home. Eggleton stated that five (5) firearms were located at the residence of David Fields. Eggleton informed me the following guns are at Fields residence. A Glock 357 caliber Serial number BSBX498, Springfield 9mm Serial number BY565071, a

22 caliber Uzi style pistol, and an AR.556 pistol.

7. Eggleton informed Agents that he would put the firearms in a bag and gave them to Fields. Fields then took the bag of firearms into 121 S 19th Street (Rear) in Pittsburgh, Allegheny County. Eggleton stated he knows Fields smokes marijuana and has seen "a couple zips" of marijuana at this residence within the past week. This terminology is known to your Affiant to mean a couple ounces of marijuana (at least 56.C) Information was obtained from Eggleton identifying the residence of 121 S 19th Street Apartment#1 in Pittsburgh as Fields residence in which the firearms are being stored in. As Agents spoke with David Fields a consent to search was obtained for his vehicle, a blue Porsche SUV. Fields also confirmed his address of 121 S 19th Street in Pittsburgh and residing there with his juvenile daughter.

8. Agents/Officers located a quantity of marijuana inside the vehicle of David Fields. Agents obtained a criminal history for Fields showing he is a person prohibited from purchasing firearms. Fields was recently denied within Pennsylvania State Police Instant Check System when trying to obtain a concealed carry permit with Allegheny County on January 25, 2021. Let it be noted that Eggleton informed this Agent; Fields accompanied him to Keystone Shooting Center on January 27, 2021 when Eggleton purchased his .357 caliber Serial number BSBX498, and Springfield 9mm Serial number BY565071. Fields knew or should have know that he was a person not to posses firearms.

9. Agents avers sufficient evidence was obtained though the course of this investigation with Earl Eggleton that firearms were being illegally purchased and transferred to David Fields. Agents then applied for and executed a search warrant at 121 South 19th Street Apartment #1 Pittsburgh Pennsylvania PA 15203. The following items were recovered from this location.

Fields knew or should have known that he is a prohibited person. Evidence of this is his recent Pennsylvania Instant Checks System (PICS) denial for an Allegheny County Concealed Carry Permit (CCP) through the Allegheny County Sherriff Department on January 25, 2021.

Based on the totality of the foregoing information, circumstances and reasonable inferences to be drawn there from, your Affiant submits that there is probable cause for filing of this criminal complaint charging David Lawrence Fields (DOB 01/06/1986) an adult male with the aforementioned felonies described above among other things.

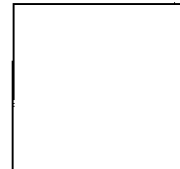

Your Affiant is an Officer with the Monroeville Police Department with over twenty five years of Law Enforcement experience.

SYNOPSIS:

Defendant REXRODE accepted a large sum of U.S. currency in plain view at the Monroeville Gun show from an under 21 years of age male JUVENILE CO-Defendant to purchase an AK handgun. REXRODE then lied on the PSP & ATF forms at which time she was discovered as a Wanted Person. REXRODE also conveyed threats of violence.

INVESTIGATIVE DETAILS:

On the above listed date and time I was working in plain clothes at the Monroeville Convention Center Gun Show people watching and conducting surveillance for criminal activity and thefts. I observed Defendant REXRODE receive in plain view a large sum of folded over U.S. currency that was rubber banded from a brown skinned Black non-Hispanic male with a royal blue shirt on who appeared to be in his teens. This male was later identified as JUVENILE Co-Defendant B/N-M-17.

This interaction caught my attention and myself and other Officers then focused on REXRODE's interactions. REXRODE then was directed to a firearm by the JUVENILE Co-Defendant and the two decided on and selected an AK Century Pistol Model M-92 762 X 39 caliber; with a 9.5 inch barrel; bearing serial # M92PV018956.

Defendant REXRODE then completed and submitted the Pennsylvania State Police SP4-113 Application / Record of Sale; transaction serial # 8326825.

On that form Defendant REXRODE lied or attempted to mislead on Question 31 answering "No" to any conditions under Pa Crimes Code 6105 c.

In fact REXRODE was a Wanted Fugitive; who has a criminal case pending in North Carolina; while supervising additional JUVENILE Co-Defendant W/N-M-16 son-who is on house arrest in Defendant REXRODE's care for a Firearm case; in violation of 6105 c 1 and 6105 c 9 Persons Prohibited under Title 18 U.S.C. 922 g 9.

REXRODE also lied when she answered question # 33 checking "yes" that she was the actual buyer; as after questioning she admitted and stated that she was purchasing a handgun for her son JUVENILE Co-Defendant W/N-M-16 with his money "for protection because you know what they are into".

REXRODE also lied on question # 34 verifying that all statements were true and correct punishable by penalty.

Defendant REXRODE also lied on the U.S. Department of Justice ATF Form 4773 specifically on: question # 21 a - Are you the actual buyer "Yes"; question # 21 b Are you under indictment or information in any court for which the judge could imprison for more than one year... ? "No"; question # 21 c have you ever been convicted of a felony or any other crime for which the judge could have imprisoned for more than one year even if you received a shorter sentence including probation? "No". Question 21 d Are you a fugitive from justice? "No". Question 21 e Are you an unlawful user or addicted to...controlled substances? "No".

REXRODE submitted the paperwork as myself and other Officers watched at which time the Pennsylvania Instant Check system (PICS) revealed REXRODE as a Wanted Person by the Westmoreland County Sheriff's Office; Reference CLEAN / NCIC NIC Entry # W012382386.

Uniform Monroeville Police Officers responded and took REXRODE into custody. REXRODE was uncooperative at times and her boyfriend with her was determined to be convicted Felon Wanted Person by the U.S. Marshal's service Leonard SMITH; FID# 830296; Case # 2:09-CR-00069-ANB. SMITH was taken into custody and the three under 21 years of age males with them were

also identified. At that time the identity of the JUVENILE Co-Defendant B/N-M-17 who provided the U.S. currency to REXRODE.

At Monroeville Police station REXRODE was Mirandized 2/6/21 approximately 1607 hours where she signed, acknowledged and waived her rights. I then went over the signed forms with Defendant REXRODE in relation to false statements. At that time REXRODE then responded to these questions by stating the following:

"I was buying the handgun for my son (JUVENILE Co-Defendant W/N-M-16 on JUVENILE house arrest for Firearms case); it was his money; he got it out of the safe. We need it for protection; because you know what he is in too.

REXRODE added in response to questioning that (JUVENILE Co-Defendant B/N-M-17) who provided the money on scene at the Gun Show was "there as a consultant to help her purchase and select a handgun.

Several additional interviews revealed that the Co-Defendant JUVENILES did not trust REXRODE with the U.S. Currency which is why they waited until the gun show to hand her the currency and standby her until the purchase was complete.

Boyfriend / Felon Wanted Person SMITH was seized with methadone as an admitted heroin user. REXRODE's Wanted Entry is a Driving Under the Influence Controlled substance Drugs / Suboxone with a warrant date of 11/13/2020.

In addition REXRODE according to previous court statements at her sons proceedings has a 4/6/2021 State of North Carolina criminal hearing.

REXRODE became irate during the interview and was physically restrained and put back in the holding cell./ REXRODE stated to myself and another Officer; she called out this Affiant's name and stated "Watch out! I remember your faces; I know your names; I got two killers in my house".

I took this and a definite threat as I have arrested both of her sons for firearms violations; and her oldest son just turned 18YOA currently in the Allegheny County Jail for a criminal attempt homicide; reference OTN# G 880270-6 Pittsburgh PD arrest.

Based on the above listed probable cause I ask that a Felony warrant for on-view arraignment be issued for Defendant REXRODE.

Your Affiant, Agent Roderick Jackson (NA Jackson), being duly sworn, deposes and says, I am Narcotics Agent employed by the Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control (OAG-BNI) assigned to the Gun Violence Section. As such, I am tasked with investigating violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code including Violations of the Uniform Firearms Act (18 Pa.C.S.A. § 6105, 6106), illegal firearm transfers and straw purchases (18 Pa.C.S.A. § 6111) and violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act of April 1972, P.L. 233, No. 64, 35 P.S. §780-101 et. seq., Corrupt Organizations (18 Pa. C.S.A. §911) and charges recommended by a statewide investigating grand jury. Your Affiant has participated in numerous illegal firearm trafficking, straw purchase investigations, narcotic investigations and related search and arrest warrants throughout the Commonwealth. I have received training from the Pennsylvania State Police that includes the Class "A" certification course for Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance conducted by the Pennsylvania State Police and Pennsylvania Attorney General. I am certified to employ such techniques while conducting criminal investigations, maintaining "A" certification number A-6142. Since obtaining the Class "A" certification, I have participated in consensual investigations. I am currently detailed to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Task Force as a federal task force officer and am tasked with investigating both state and federal violations relative to firearms trafficking, straw purchasing and felons in possession of firearms.

Your Co-Affiant, Detective Robert Renk of the Monroeville Police Department is a law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania within the meaning of section 5702, Title 18 Pa. C.S.A, and as such, I am empowered to make arrests for the criminal offenses enumerated in Title 18 and 35, PA C.S.A. He has been a Monroeville Police Officer since October of 2012 and has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division since July 2014.

On Saturday, February 6, 2021, Officers from the Monroeville Police Department and Agents from Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General (PAOAG) were conducting a surveillance detail at the Monroeville Convention Center. This detail was the result of a recent increase in multiple straw purchases and thefts at prior Monroeville Showmasters gun shows. At approximately 1528 hours, I observed Robert Raglin, a known person not to possess firearms due to a prior conviction of 6105. Raglin was actively looking at firearms within the main show room. I immediately notified officers and began to monitor Raglin's movements inside of the show. I then exited the show and entered the parking lot to identify one of two known vehicles driven by Raglin and Olverson. The Chevy Tahoe License number LJLW-1727 was parked in the south entrance across from the loading dock. The Tahoe is known to be registered to Tanesha Olverson who is Raglin's girlfriend. Raglin is also known to use the Chevrolet Tahoe.

At approximately 1540 hours, Raglin approached a rear show case table for Petronio Family Firearms. Tanesha Olverson was seated at the table completing a Pennsylvania State Police Application Record of Sale for a Firearm form (4473). Both Olverson and Raglin were the subjects of a prior PAOAG straw purchasing investigation under GVS-200019. Raglin then left the back area and returned to the south section of the show. At 1618 hours, Raglin was observed looking at several ammunition vendors and purchased two boxes of .45 ACP and five boxes of PMC.223, and three laser sights. Upon Olverson completing the sale at Petronio, she took the box with the gun that she had just bought and she then went to Georges Enterprises at approximately 1625 hours with Raglin. Olverson sat down to purchase another firearm from Georges. Raglin sat down next to her. The gun that she had previously purchased from Petronio's was still in the box to her right. Raglin sat down next to her. After a few minutes Raglin then took possession of box later found to contain the B-15 .556 AR Rifle. Raglin placed the boxed firearm in his lap and was looking into the box. This action was done while he was seated directly next to Olverson while she was completing a second Pennsylvania State Police Application Record of Sale for a Firearm form (4473). At approximately 1640 hours, Raglin stood up and exited the main show room carrying the ammunition and lasers that he bought and the boxed B-15.556 AR Rifle. Raglin was then detained by Officers outside as he approached the Chevrolet Tahoe.

At approximately 1708 hours, Olverson departed the premises carrying the Glock Model 21 .45 and was detained by Officers as she approached the Chevrolet Tahoe. Olverson was read her Miranda Rights and Waiver and consented to a search of her Chevy Tahoe LJW-1727. As a result of the search, Officers retrieved the following.

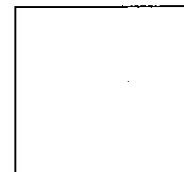
