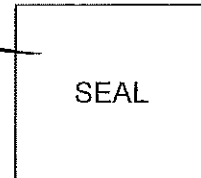

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

1. Your Affiant, Stephanie L. McElhaney, is a Narcotics Agent with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control and is currently assigned to the Butler, Region 6 office where your Affiant has been responsible for the investigation of violations of the Pennsylvania Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, ACT 64 of 1972. Your Affiant has conducted investigations involving the prescribing practices of providers in the medical community including doctors, nurses and other health care professionals. Your Affiant has attended Drug Diversion training provided by the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators and training provided by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General. Your Affiant has also conducted drug investigations involving the delivery and/or possession with intent to deliver various controlled substances including cocaine, crack cocaine, marijuana, methamphetamine and heroin. These investigations have led to the seizure of controlled substances and the arrest and prosecution of offenders. As a result, your Affiant has experience in investigating violations of the Drug Act and the Crimes Code.

2. Your Affiant has received a Bachelor of Science from La Roche College and an Associate's Degree from the Community College of the Air Force. Your Affiant is "A" certified in Wiretap and Electronic Surveillance from the Pennsylvania State Police. Your Affiant has also received additional training from the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network, the Institute for Law Enforcement Education, Northeast Counter Drug Training Center, and the National Cyber Forensics Training Alliance.

3. As an Agent of the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, your Affiant is empowered by law to conduct investigations of, and to make arrests for, offenses involving violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act (C.S.D.D.C.A.) of April, 1972, P. L. 233, No. 64, Section 1, et seq., and related offenses under the Pennsylvania Crimes Code.

4. Your Affiant is Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Trooper Jeremy Fairman. Your Affiant is a full-time sworn law enforcement officer and is assigned to PSP Punxsutawney Station. Your Affiant is authorized to conducted investigations into violations of PA Title 18 (PA Crimes Code), and PA Title 75 (PA Vehicle Code). As such, your Affiant has conducted all necessary investigative methods which have led to the arrest and prosecution of offenders.

5. On February 6, 2021, Affiant Fairman and Trooper Kurtis Jacoby conducted a traffic stop on a 2020 white Toyota Rav-4, bearing PA registration LBW-2373, on SR-410, north of Pike Road in Henderson Township, Jefferson County. The vehicle was observed swerving across the center line as well as driving on

the left side of the roadway. Trooper Fairman observed the vehicle using its right turn signal three-times without making a turning movement and the vehicle expiration was identified as being expired as 01/21. Affiant Fairman activates lights and the vehicle pulled to the side of the road. Affiant Fairman and Trooper Jacoby approached the vehicle and identified it was occupied by two individuals. Affiant Fairman approached the driver's side of the vehicle and identified the vehicle operator to be Kimari Leigh JACKSON via her Ohio Driver's License. Trooper Jacoby approached the passenger side of the vehicle and identified the passenger to be Kareem Jabbar ROCK II via his United States Passport card and Aboriginal American National identification card. Both Trooper Jacoby and your Affiant returned to the patrol vehicle and queried ROCK and JACKSON through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC). It was identified ROCK had two (2) active warrants from Cuyahoga County, Ohio, through the Garfield Heights Police Department for robbery, resisting, trafficking and possession (W741298884). The second warrant was identified from Cuyahoga County, Ohio, through the Eastlake Police Department for trafficking, drug possession, possession of criminal tools, failure to comply, resisting arrest, fleeing and eluding (W991582522). Following this, Affiant Fairman and Trooper Jacoby detained ROCK and placed him in the rear of patrol unit C1-09.

6. Affiant Fairman returned to the operator, JACKSON, and asked JACKSON if there was anything illegal in the vehicle. JACKSON related that he had marijuana and provided a small plastic baggie with a green leafy substance, approximately 6.3 grams, to Affiant Fairman. Following this, Affiant Fairman requested a consent search of the vehicle to which JACKSON denied. JACKSON was placed under arrest for possession of a small amount of marijuana.

7. The vehicle was identified via the PENNDOT license and registration to be owned by PV Holding Corporation, Pittsburgh International Airport, PO Box 12307, Pittsburgh PA 15231. The VIN identified as 2T3F1RFB2LC093085. The lessee information was identified as AVIS, located at 300 Centre Pointe Drive, VA Beach, BA 23462, and a registration expiration of January 2021. While detained, ROCK stated that since PSP was in possession of the aforementioned vehicle that any items located were property of the police and not their possessions. The vehicle was seized and towed to the PSP Punxsutawney Station. Punxsutawney Borough Police Chief Matthew Conrad and canine officer "Fury" conducted an exterior search of the vehicle with a positive indication on the rear of the vehicle. The vehicle and keys were placed into evidence at PSP Punxsutawney. Affiant Fairman then applied for and obtained a search warrant from Magisterial District Judge Greg Bazylak at approximately 0630 hours on February 6, 20201, for the white Toyota RAV-4, bearing Pennsylvania registration LBW-2373.

8. The search of the vehicle was executed by Affiant Fairman and Trooper Pisano. The search identified under the driver's seat, a vacuum sealed container of crystal methamphetamine weighting approximately 590 grams contained within a Taco Bell bag. The illicit substances were NiK tested which yielded a positive result for crystal methamphetamine. Additionally located in the vehicle was the rental agreement identifying the vehicle was rented by Kimari JACKSON on January 29, 2021, from Budget Rental Vehicle located at 27900 Chagrin Boulevard, Beachwood, Ohio 44122, with a scheduled return date of February 5, 2021, and a set of hotel room keys for room 309 at the Best Western Plus, located at 14424 Clearfield-Shawville Highway, Clearfield PA 16830.

9. Affiant McElhaney and Jefferson County Drug Task Force (JCDF) Officer William Craddock, arrived at PSP Punxsutawney following notification of the traffic stop and arrest of ROCK and JACKSON. Affiant McElhaney and Officer Craddock had information, prior to the traffic stop, that ROCK was in possession of a large quantity of crystal methamphetamine and that he would be in the local area until it was "gone".

10. Affiant McElhaney and Trooper Craig Needham read JACKSON her Miranda Rights to which she signed and waived, agreeing to speak with us. JACKSON stated that she and ROCK had just arrived in the area when they were pulled over. She stated that they were here to visit friends and family and denied any knowledge of renting a room or knowledge of the crystal methamphetamine which was located under her seat.

11. Affiant Fairman identified during the initial interaction with JACKSON that her phone was opened to the GPS which was directing them to Best Western Plus. Troopers confirmed with the hotel staff that Room 309 in the Best Western Plus, located at 14424 Clearfield-Shawville Highway, Clearfield PA, had been rented to Kimari JACKSON. Affiant McElhaney and Officer Craddock applied for, and obtained a search warrant for Best Western Plus, located at 14424 Clearfield-Shawville Highway, Clearfield PA, Room 309.

12. At approximately 16:02 hours, on the aforementioned date, PSP Troopers, Officer Craddock, and Affiant McElhaney executed the search warrant on the hotel room. No one was present in the room. Affiant McElhaney identified a loaded firearm, identified as an American Arms Inc. PK-22 pistol, located on the desk sitting beside a stuff Nemo fish. Your Affiants know that ROCK has two (2) previous convictions for felony drug trafficking related offenses in 2015 and 2017. Affiant McElhaney identified that the fish had been cut open and concealed within were several bags of illicit substances to include two bags containing suspected crystal methamphetamine, bag one contained approximately 201.5 grams, bag two contained approximately

68 grams; a bag containing 30.7 grams of an suspected cocaine; and a bag containing 150 Morphine 30 mg tablets. In addition to the illicit substances, two overnight bags were identified. One bag contained items belonging to Kimari JACKSON which included numerous purple nitrile gloves, and indicia with her name and identifying information provided. The other bag contained items belonging to Kareem ROCK II which included sovereign citizen's identification, passport, and indicia containing his identifying information. All evidence was secured and transported to the PA OAG Butler Region VI office where it was placed into evidence in accordance with policy and procedure.

13. Based upon the aforementioned information as described above, your Affiants believe there is probable cause to issue an arrest warrant for Kimari Leigh Jackson.
