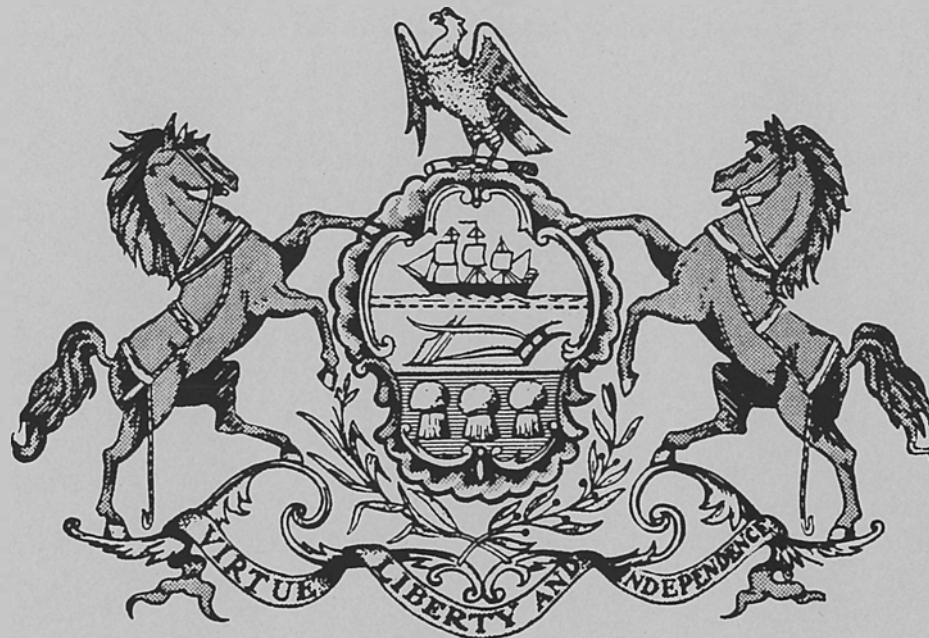

## INTRODUCTION

This Annual Report is submitted to the Appropriations and Judiciary Committees of the Senate and the Appropriations and Judiciary Committees of the House of Representatives to provide the Legislature with an accounting of the property forfeited under the provisions of the Controlled Substances Forfeitures Act, an Act of June 30, 1988, Act No. 1988-79, 42 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6801 et seq. Section 6801(j) of the Controlled Substances Forfeitures Act provides that the Attorney General shall annually submit a report specifying the forfeited property or proceeds thereof obtained under this section. The report shall give an accounting of all proceeds derived from the sale of forfeited property and the use made of unsold forfeited property.

As this Act provides for utilization of the forfeiture provisions by both the Attorney General and the District Attorneys of the counties in the Commonwealth, this report contains information on property forfeited to the Commonwealth collected pursuant to the law, by the Office of Attorney General as well as the District Attorneys of the Commonwealth.

## DEFINITIONS

### INCOME

**Cash Forfeitures.** Seized cash forfeited.

**Proceeds Received from Sale of Forfeited Property.** Seized property forfeited and ultimately sold.

**Interest.** Interest earned in restricted forfeiture accounts.

**Other.** Contributions, grants or income unspecified.

### EXPENSES

**Confidential Case Expenditures.** Costs associated with confidential drug cases to include drug buys and informant expenses.

**Municipal Task Force Support.** Costs associated with task forces and/or payments to municipal police departments.

**Maintenance of Forfeited Property.** Costs associated with the maintenance or sale of forfeited property to include but not limited to liens, storage, advertising, auctions, taxes, utility bills, physical maintenance and lawn care services.

**Salaries.** Costs associated with salary expenses to include salaries, overtime and benefits (not salary costs associated with municipal task forces).

**Vehicles.** Costs associated with operating vehicles to include purchase, rental, repairs and automotive supplies.

**Investigative Equipment/Supplies.** Costs associated with the purchase, rental, repair or service of investigative equipment to include cellular phones, pagers, weapons, apparel and electronic equipment.

**EDP Equipment/Supplies.** Costs associated with the purchase, rental, repair or service of EDP equipment to include computers, printers, software and supplies.

**Other Equipment/Supplies.** Costs associated with the purchase, rental, repair or service of office equipment to include typewriters, filing cabinets, furniture, telephones and supplies.

**Deposited in Fund.** Monies deposited in a fund to be used to enforce the provisions of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act.

**Shared Forfeitures.** Monies shared with local, state, and/or federal

governments which was derived from a shared investigation.

**Training.** Costs associated with conferences and investigative training.

**Education.** Costs associated with school, public and other community drug awareness educational programs.

**Miscellaneous.** All other expenses not fitting into the above categories.
