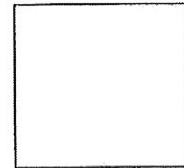

**5. WHY AFFIANT BELIEVES THE SOURCE OF INFORMATION:**

- X Source is presumed reliable, i.e. other Police Officer, Eyewitness, Victim of Crime, etc.

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1. Your Affiant is Richard Castagna, a Narcotics Agent II employed by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control. Your Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer since 2014. Previously your Affiant was employed by the City of Clairton. In that time I have held multiple positions including that of Patrol Officer, Plain Clothes Officer, Narcotics Detective, as well as a Task Force Officer for the Office of Attorney General Bureau of Narcotics Investigation. I have worked alongside multiple agencies including the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI), the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), and the Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF).

2. Since May 2019, your Affiant has been employed by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General in the Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the Bureau of Narcotics Investigations, Region V. As a Narcotics Agent of the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control, your Affiant is empowered by law to conduct investigations of, and to make arrests for offenses involving violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act and related offenses under the Pennsylvania Crimes Code, Title 18. Your Affiant, while employed as a Narcotics Agent II and a City of Clairton Narcotics Detective, has been involved in many investigations concerning narcotics violations and of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. Furthermore, your Affiant has debriefed numerous informants, drug users and drug dealers about illegal drug trafficking, the codes and cryptic language used by drug users and drug dealers, and the methods and practices used by drug dealers in furtherance of their drug trafficking enterprises. As a result of his training and experience, your Affiant has knowledge regarding illegal drugs and the business of illegal drug sales, as well as the methods utilized by drug traffickers in the sale and distribution of controlled substances. This includes, but is not limited to, the tactics and methods of communication, including the fact that drug users and traffickers often speak in "code" when discussing drugs and drug transactions, and other methods employed by illegal drug traffickers in furtherance of their criminal conduct and in an effort to avoid law enforcement detection. Your Affiant has also attended and completed the Pennsylvania State Police A Certification Wire Tapping School.

3. Your Affiant has conducted and/or participated in several investigations which have resulted in the seizure of assets; currency and money; books, records, receipts, notes, ledgers, and/or other papers relating to the transportation, ordering, sale, and/or distribution of drugs.

4. Your affiant is Sgt. Steven Kondrosky, a City of McKeesport Sergeant of Detectives currently assigned to the Narcotics Unit, deposes the following to be true and factual to the best of my knowledge. All of the information contained herein has been discovered by your affiant or received from other persons directly involved in this investigation. Your affiant has 13 years of law enforcement experience with specialized training in Narcotics Investigations.

5. On Thursday 07/22/2021 Narcotics Agents from Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General BNI SRT-West along with the McKeesport Police department applied for and was granted a search warrant by the Honorable Judge Eugene Riazzi. The search warrant that was granted was for the residence of 2249 (B) Ridge Rd; McKeesport, PA (Allegheny County). The search warrant was signed at 1333 hours.

6. At 1300 hours Agents were set on the front and back of the residence for pre entry surveillance. At or about 1315 hours the target of the investigation – Franklin Gribschaw – exited the front door of the residence with an unnamed male juvenile. Gribschaw stayed outside for a period of time. As soon as the search warrant was signed Agents and Officers moved in to detain Gribschaw outside of his residence. Narcotics Agent Castagna exited an unmarked vehicle with "POLICE" markings displayed. NA Castagna announced "police do not move." Gribschaw attempted to flee at this time. Gribschaw was subsequently taken to the ground and detained. The unnamed juvenile remained by a vehicle and proper precautions were taken for the care and custody of juvenile. Agents and Officers gained entry into the residence through the front door that was unlocked. A female (later identified as Nicole Wall) was ordered to come downstairs. Wall complied with orders and was detained at the bottom of the steps. A search of the residence for any additional persons yielded negative. At this time with Gribschaw and Wall detained and they were read there

7. Gribshaw was transported to the McKeesport Police Station. Once at McKeesport lock up Detective Lt. Summers searched Gribshaw. He was found to have 11 grams of crystal methamphetamine, 2 grams of crack cocaine, and (1) brick of heroin from his waist band. A search of Gribshaw's wallet showed that he had \$540.00 in United States Currency and off that \$540.00 prerecorded advanced BNI funds were recovered. Also a cell phone was seized from Gribshaw's person. A blocked call was placed to the cell phone number 412-583-8719 which was the number Agents had used to contact Gribshaw for the controlled buys. The phone that was seized from Gribshaw began to ring showing an incoming call from a blocked number.

8. The .22LR rifle with obliterated numbers was found less than 20 inches from the black and blue bookbag that contained majority of the narcotics. The heroin, cocaine, crack cocaine, MDMA, and crystal methamphetamine were all tested with a NIK kit. Each particular narcotic yielded a positive presence for the individual NIK kit that was used. The Xanax pills were researched utilizing the DRUG ID check. The pills had the same stamp, shape and color of that of Xanax on the DRUG ID.

9. The one pill bottle that was seized has the name of the unnamed juvenile on it for a prescription for Dextroamp. Inside the bottle that is prescribed for the male juvenile was a piece of white paper balled up inside that contained (1) gram of crack cocaine. Also the firearm that was located in the master bedroom could of been accessed by the male juvenile due to the fact of it being placed on the floor and fully loaded. There was no gun lock on the weapon.

10. With the above information Your Affiants, Narcotics Agent Rich Castagna and Sgt. Steven Kondrosky, respectfully request that Franklin Gribshaw be charged with the aforementioned charges.
