At that time, I had an established business that supports my family and allowed me the opportunity to purchase said property with the intent of expanding my business operations overall. The local township has issue with current operations and all documentation regarding my case with the township is enclosed.

I am requesting a review of the local ordinances.

I have an office and shop for my business on the property – the office has one employee who does the general bookkeeping. There are about 9 company trucks and 6 trailers onsite. Employees do arrive in the morning to pick up company vehicles. Their personal vehicles are parked on the property during the work day. Being a seasonal business, the number of employees varies from a few in the winter up to two dozen total fulltime and parttime employees in the summer months.

I also have two personal vehicles and two personal trailers on the property.

Equipment such as mowers, trimmers, mulchers used for off-site jobs are stored and maintained in buildings on the property. There are 3-4 snow plows stored outside on the property.

Currently on the property, my family resides in the farmhouse – this is our current personal residence. We have thus far acquired livestock of 6 steers, 26 chickens, 3 roosters and 3 goats.

We have had minimal plant sales to the public and are in the process of planting 2,000 Green Giant evergreens.

We have a supply of mulch with some sales to the public, but majority has been used this year on my own off-site jobs.

All operations in my opinion are agriculture related. I am working on establishing and growing a nursery on the property.
