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Your Affiant, Narcotics Agent Joseph Barna, being duly sworn according to law, avers that the following is true and correct to the best of his knowledge, information and belief and is based on personal knowledge or information provided by reliable sources:

Your Affiant, Joseph D. Barna, a Narcotics Agent II employed by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control. Your Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer since January of 2009. Your Affiant, from January of 2009 to August 2012 was an Indiana County Probation Officer. Your Affiant, from August of 2012 until November of 2015 was a Pittsburgh Police Officer. Since November of 2015, your Affiant has been employed with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General in the Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the North Huntingdon Office, Narcotics Division. As a Narcotics Agent of the Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control, your Affiant is empowered by law to conduct investigations of, and to make arrests for offenses involving violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act and related offense under the Pennsylvania Crimes Code.

Your Affiant, while employed as a Narcotics Agent II, Pittsburgh Police Officer, and Indiana County Probation Officer, has been involved in hundreds of investigations concerning narcotics violations and of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. While employed at the city of Pittsburgh Police, your Affiant worked as a Patrol Officer, Zone Detective and Narcotics Detective. During your Affiant's career as a Pittsburgh Police Officer, your Affiant had been involved in hundreds of arrests and convictions. Specifically, your Affiant has made over 100 arrests for violations of the Drug Device and Cosmetic Act, resulting in numerous convictions for these offenses.

Your Affiant has applied for, obtained and executed search warrants, as well as made seizures of narcotics, firearms and other materials involved in the packaging and distribution of narcotics. Your Affiant has been involved in numerous undercover purchases of controlled substances. Your Affiant has extensively interviewed dozens of individuals involved in selling or using of illegal narcotics. These individuals have provided your Affiant with detailed information concerning the terminology of the sale of narcotics, how illegal narcotics are sold, manufactured, cultivated and used. Your Affiant has attended numerous trainings and academies as a Probation Officer, Police Officer and Narcotics Agent.

In January of 2018, your Affiant completed the Class "A" Pennsylvania State Police Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance Training School as mandated in Title 18 Pa. C.S. § 5724 and received Class "A" certification Number A-5494. Your Affiant has participated in three (3) non-consensual electronic surveillance investigations with the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control, as an affiant, co-affiant, surveillance Agent and monitoring Agent.

As a result of his training and experience, your Affiant has extensive knowledge regarding illegal drugs and the business of illegal drug sales, as well as the methods utilized by drug traffickers in the sale and distribution of controlled substances. This includes but not limited to, the tactics and methods of communication, including the fact that drug users and traffickers often speak in "code" when discussing drug and drug transactions, and other methods employed by illegal drug traffickers in furtherance of their criminal conduct and in an effort to avoid law enforcement detection.

Affiant Barna is empowered by law to conduct investigations of and to make arrests for offenses involving violations of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act of April 14, 1972, P.L. 233, No. 64, Section 1, et seq., and related offenses under the Pennsylvania Crimes Code.

1. On March 9, 2022, at approximately 10:10am, I applied for and was granted a sealed search Warrant for 19 Moody Street, Braddock, PA 15104. The sealed search warrant was signed by Common Pleas Judge Bigley.



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2. On March 11, 2022, at 7:30 hours, Monroeville Police, Munhall Police, Elizabeth Township Police, Penn Hills Police and Agents from the Pennsylvania Attorney General's office met and formulated a plan to execute the search warrant at 19 Moody Street, Braddock, PA 15104.

3. Entry was made into the residence at 09:41am. There were numerous cameras outside the residence and inside the entryway to the residence. Inside the entry way of the residence was an additional camera and an open front door. Several knock and announcements were made in the entryway of the residence. Due to the cameras on our location, the front door being open and no one responding, Law Enforcement went into the residence. Inside the entry hallway of the residence Porscha Brown, was detained without incident. Brown was hand cuffed behind the back, checked for tightness and walked to the front of 19 Moody Street. While clearing the residence, verbal commands of "Police, search warrant were being yelled." Additional commands for Domonique Taylor to show himself and come to Police were made. Taylor was found walking up the basement steps and stated that he was getting food for his dogs. Taylor was detained, handcuffed behind the back, checked for tightness and moved to the dining room of the residence. A search for additional people inside the residence was conducted with negative results for people.

4. A search of 19 Moody Street was conducted and the following was recovered:

- Drum magazine for 12 gauge shotgun
- Loaded magazine for Glock Pistol
- Anderson Rifle, AM-15, multi caliber, Serial #20136602 with two loaded magazines, green assault rifle case

- Cash in "Nike Boy"
- Cash in "Clear Container"
- Sipahi honing and tactical, 12 gauge, serial BS-12-10842, black rifle case
- Box of cash
- Glock Pistol, model 27, 40 caliber with conversion kit to make a mini rifle, with two loaded magazines
- Adidas bag with numerous bags of marijuana.
- 2 magazines and various ammunition in plastic boxes
- Sig Saur, p226, 9mm, serial 47A072038
- 2 magazines and ammunition in guitar case
- 2 bags of cocaine and cutting agent
- Cocaine with scale, from black duffel bag
- Cocaine in "Car Quest" cooler
- Cash in bag
- Cash in "Jump Man" box
- Five digital scales
- Various bags of marijuana, 5 dollar bill inside a shoebox
- Paraphernalia
- Mini white sealed buckets with marijuana and 2 digital scales

5. A search of the residence yielded in excess of \$535,000 dollars in United States Currency, ounces of cocaine and numerous pounds of marijuana, packaging materials, scales to weigh, package and distribute these narcotics. Also in the residence was numerous firearms in different cases. The marijuana was found in a blue and black over the shoulder duffel bag and white plastic buckets. The cocaine was found in a small soft lunch box and a medium size black duffel bag.

6. The following vehicles and trailers were seized from the residence,

7. Taylor was read his Miranda warnings on camera by Detective Maritz and agreed to speak with Law Enforcement. Taylor was transported to the Monroeville Police Department.

8. Taylor was viewed moving these buckets, duffel bags, brown gun boxes, numerous assault rifle cases, numerous times from the beginning of January of 2022. The assault weapon cases have no other legitimate use other than to hold firearms. Through the execution of the search warrant we were able to verify assault rifles inside these gun cases. In the blue and black duffel bag we were able to verify the large amount of marijuana inside the residence. Inside the lunch box and medium duffel bag we were able to verify cocaine inside the bags. Taylor is a convicted felon, with a prior PWID/F in Sapulapa, Oklahoma on March 3, 2004. Taylor was also convicted of prohibited offensive weapon on December 1, 2010, to which also makes him a person not to possess a firearm. Taylor was also convicted by the ATF on August 5, 2005 for a firearms violation. Taylor can be viewed moving the buckets, duffel bags, black assault rifle cases, and gun boxes from the residence to the Harley trailer bearing PA plate XLN1399 which is parked in front of Taylors house. The trailer's plate was ran on PA Departments of transportation and he is the registered owner. Taylor was also viewed moving these items from the residence to the trailer and to the garage located behind 120 camp Avenue, Braddock, PA 15104 in no specific order. On Allegheny County real estate website, it shows that Domonique Taylor is the owner of 120 Camp Avenue and 19 Moody Street.

9. Through digital surveillance since January of 2022, Taylor has been the only person utilizing the garage behind 120 Camp Avenue. Since January of 2022, Taylor can be viewed utilizing the garage numerous times located behind 120 camp street to move and place the duffel bags, gun boxes, assault weapon cases and numerous pieces of luggage.

10. Taylor owns 22 vehicles, numerous properties, and admitted to paying cash for everything. Taylor states that he sells vehicles on the side for cash and that is how he makes a living. Taylor also stated that in the warmer months he operates a landscaping company. I asked Taylor if he has filed taxes and or reports an income and he stated that he does not report an income and does not have an income. Taylor states that he only deals with cash. Taylor states that he has had no income for three years and has not filed taxes. I asked if he realized that he needs to pay taxes and he said if its just cash, he does not have to. I asked about the Corvette inside the garage behind 120 Camp Avenue and he stated that he paid \$8500 cash for it last February. Taylor states that he owns several garages and a couple rental properties that he paid cash for and is paid cash for rent. Taylor admitted to moving the drugs from his residence to the Harley Trailer and to the garage behind 120 Camp Avenue. Taylor stated that he didn't want to keep everything inside his residence due to people coming into his house to buy drugs and that he was in fear that they would come steal them. Taylor states that he does not have a medical marijuana license.

11. A search warrant was authored on March 11, 2022 for the garage behind 120 Camp Street, Braddock, PA 15104. The garage is a separate garage that is not attached to the residence. Through surveillance on this building since the beginning of January, Taylor was the only person to open the garage and ever access but one time where someone helped him move a box outside the garage. The box was a large "power wheels box" which was transported to his residence. The search warrant was signed by District Judge Stephens on March 11, 2022 at 5:10pm.

12. Law Enforcement had constant surveillance on the garage door and man door of the garage. At approximately 5:49pm, forced entry was made into the man door of the garage. The following was located inside the garage:

- 14 Kilos of fentanyl from black, Adidas bag
- Black rifle case, containing an Anderson MFG AM-15 rifle, serial number 20254610, with loaded magazines
- Vacuum sealed tub aware container containing an unknown substance
- American gun company, sawed off shotgun, no serial number, 12 inch barrel, 21 inch overall length
- Box containing stamp bags of heroin
- 2 clear bag containing several bundles of heroin
- 2, 40 caliber handgun magazines
- 2 extended magazines
- 1, 9mm handgun magazine
- 1 vacuum sealed bag containing marijuana
- 1 white Chevrolet, Corvette, vin number 1G14422G8w5116312
- 1 black Chevrolet, Impala, bearing PA plate KPV9018, vin number 1G1BL52P97R187609

13. From the residence located at 19 Moody Street, approximately 18 ounces of cocaine was seized with a street value of \$28,000. Approximately 2 pounds of marijuana in large bags, 10 clear baggies of marijuana, 20 smaller baggies of marijuana, and marijuana edibles. Due to my training and experience, this amount of narcotics is far more than for personal use but for resale due to the fact of the packaging materials, a kilo press, and scales.

14. Located in the residence was over \$535,000 in United States Currency, Taylor states that he has no legitimate job and that he has not filed and or reported an income in three years. With Taylor not having a job and through all surveillance never viewing Taylor working a job it is believed that Taylor is laundering drug proceeds through purchasing vehicles and properties. Taylor also admitted to purchasing all the listed vehicles, trailers and properties with paying for cash. He also admitted that he does not think that he has to pay taxes and report income on cash purchases and sales.

15. Located inside the garage behind 120 Camp Avenue, was an additional pound of marijuana, a kilo of an unknown substance and 14 kilos of Fentanyl. A kilogram of fentanyl has approximately 1,000 grams of fentanyl inside them. Each gram of fentanyl

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can supply 50 individual doses of heroin. With there being 14 kilos of fentanyl this would make out to be 700,000 individual doses of heroin with a street value of \$1,500,00 worth of fentanyl. It is believed due to my training and experience and the large amount of narcotics seized that Taylor is a high level drug dealer which is supported by the large amount of United States Currency. The money laundering is supported by the amount of vehicles and trailers that Taylor owns and that all of them are paid off. Taylor also owns a house, a rental property and several vacant lots, which are all paid off. Taylor admits that he does not pay taxes and has not filed taxes in over three years.

16. Detective TFO Maritz and I met Richard Colella who is the Hazardous Material Coordinator for Allegheny County. Colella is supplied with a Thermo Scientific Gemini model GM2418. The Thermo Scientific Gemini is made to test narcotics and is used like a Nik test and other testing devices. Out of the 14 kilos, 6 were tested and yielded positive results for Fentanyl.

17. All evidence was transported to the region V evidence room. The evidence was processed and will be sent to the Pennsylvania State Police Crime lab for further analysis. This case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office. Taylor was transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
