Hello. I live in Connellsville twp and have had livestock for several years. We have 1.000 acres and are zoned as A-1. Today, we received a letter from the Fayette County Code Enforcement claiming that a person must own 1.83 acres or 80,000 sq Ft of land to own even a single chicken. They're trying to force me into paying a hideous amount of money to become "compliant." I was given 30 days to clear out or pay the money to become "compliant." I hope I can get some guidance here. Please let me know what I can do next and whether this is legal. We raise fowl for food and eggs and sheep and goats for what we were hoping to turn into a business in 2023. If we have to get rid of all of our animals, that will destroy our dreams of owning animals and being small business owners. Please help!
