Re: ACRE Request for Review – Tinicum Township – Bucks County

Dear Mr. Willig:

Please be advised that I serve as the Township Solicitor for Tinicum Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Your letter of April 13, 2023 was forwarded to me for response. I believe a little history will help clarify the situation regarding the [REDACTED] property.

[REDACTED] applied for an H-1 Home Occupation Permit on December 1, 1999 – see Exhibit “A” attached hereto. In response to her application, the Township issued the requested permit and renewed it on at least one occasion – see Exhibit “B” attached hereto. You can see from the notation on the permit that the permit was to be automatically renewed until the owner discontinued the use. The Township is unaware whether the [REDACTED] continued their winery after 2002 or simply resumed recently after years of inactivity. In any event, as you can see from Exhibit “C” attached hereto, the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture inspected the property on August 11, 2022 in order to conduct an investigation into a possible unregistered food establishment. At that inspection, [REDACTED] was found to be illegally operating an unregistered food establishment that manufactured bottled wine and various jarred food products, as well as operating a full service bar and retail facility, which facility lacked proper equipment, and finishes to operate as a food establishment. A makeshift outdoor kitchen with various food contact information was observed outside and along the exterior of the building. At that inspection, [REDACTED] was unable to provide any proof of registration from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture to operate as a food establishment and he lacked a retail food license from the Bucks County Department of Health. As a result of the inspection [REDACTED] agreed to voluntarily close and a follow-up inspection was scheduled for the following day with the Bucks County Department of Health.

The Township’s Code Enforcement Office [REDACTED] attended the inspection on August 12, 2022, together with representatives of the Bucks County Department of Health at the

invitation of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. As you can see from the email from the Department of Agriculture:

per Code Enforcement Officer [REDACTED] this facility lacked local zoning approval to operate, *citing deficiencies in local code such as lack of public restrooms, lack of handicap accessibility, and a building not fit for habitation and lacking emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, etc.* (emphasis added)

The representative of the Department of Agriculture also reported in her email that the Department of Health noted that the septic system did not meet their regulations to support the operations. Again, [REDACTED] agreed to voluntarily cease and desist all operations going forward.

As a result of that inspection, the Township issued a stop work order – see Exhibit “D” attached hereto for violations of the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code and the building was posted as being an unsafe structure – see Exhibit “E” attached hereto. All of the action at this point was taken pursuant to the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code which provides in part:

The Commonwealth has also empowered local government units to protect the health, safety and welfare of their citizens and to ensure that normal agricultural operations do not negatively impact upon the health, safety and welfare of the citizens.

The failure to comply with the requirements of the Uniform Construction Code and provide a permitted septic system are health, safety and welfare issues. Furthermore, although the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code has an exemption for agricultural buildings, the bar and retail store being operated by [REDACTED] does not fit the definition which is:

“Agricultural Building.” A structure utilized to store farm implements, hay, feed, grain or other agricultural or horticultural products, to house poultry, livestock or other farm animals, milk cows and a structure used to grow mushrooms. The term includes a carriage house owned and used by members of a recognized religious sect for the purposes of housing horses and storing buggies.

The term shall *not include habitable space or spaces* in which agricultural products are processed, treated or packaged and shall *not be construed to mean a place of occupancy by the general public.* (emphasis added)

In addition, the Township issued an Enforcement Notice for violations of its Zoning Ordinance because (1) by changing the use of the property without first securing a zoning permit; (2) occupying a structure which has undergone a change in use from a storage building to a retail shop without receiving a Certificate of Occupancy; (3) operating a retail store, eating place and

tavern without first securing a zoning permit; and (4) installing signs without first securing a zoning permit.

The Enforcement Notice notified [REDACTED] that they had a right to appeal the Notice to the Zoning Hearing Board. No appeal was filed.

Finally, when [REDACTED] continued to operate without complying with the requirements of the Uniform Construction Code and without securing the necessary building permits even though they agreed to voluntarily close their operation, citations were filed with the local Magisterial District Justice – see Exhibit “G” attached hereto, and after a hearing, the Magisterial District Justice found [REDACTED] guilty and imposed a fine. [REDACTED] has filed an appeal to the Court of Common Pleas and that appeal is scheduled for a hearing on Friday, April 28, 2023.

I hope this letter clarifies the situation. I respectfully suggest that the actions taken by the Township in response to the investigations undertaken by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, the Bucks County Department of Health and the Township revealing multiple violations of each of their regulations is not in violation of the ACRE Act and I request that Complaint be dismissed.

Please do not hesitate to contact me if you require clarification of any of the issues.

(H1) Home Occupation

Customary home occupation for gain. A home occupation shall:

a) Conform to the following regulations:

- (1) The home occupation shall be carried on wholly indoors and within a dwelling or other structure accessory thereto.
- (2) There shall be no show windows, display or advertising visible outside the premises to attract customers or clients other than a home occupation sign as permitted in Article X.
- (3) There shall be no exterior storage of materials.
- (4) No external alterations, additions, or changes to the structure shall be permitted in order to accommodate or facilitate a home occupation.
- (5) No articles shall be sold or offered for sale on premises except such as may be produced on the premises.
- (6) Frequent and repetitive servicing by commercial vehicle for supplies and materials shall not be permitted.
- (7) The home occupation shall be operated only by members of the immediate family residing in the dwelling.
- (8) The floor area devoted to a home occupation shall not be more than twenty-five (25) percent of the ground floor area of the principal residential structure, excluding garage.

b) Include, but not be limited to, the following: art studio, teaching of not more than four (4) pupils simultaneously; or in the case of musical instruction not more than a single pupil at a time; seamstress, handicrafts or other like activity, barber shop and beauty parlor limited to serving one patron at a time; and greenhouse.

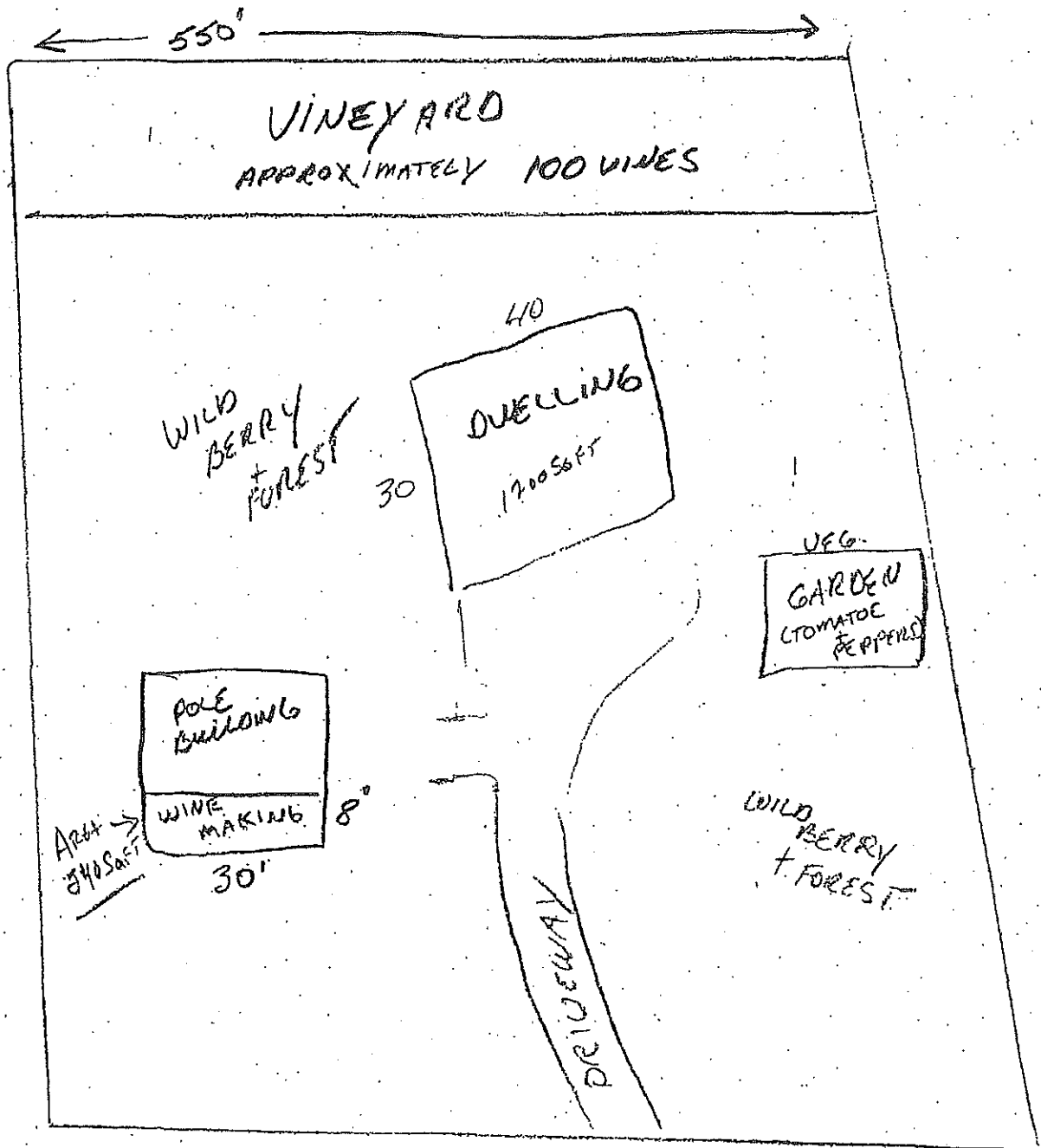
c) Not include the following: animal hospital; commercial stable or kennel; funeral parlor or undertaking establishment; antique shop; tourist home; restaurant; or rooming, boarding or lodging house.

Parking: Two (2) off-street parking spaces in addition to spaces otherwise required.

Good Afternoon,

To provide a recap of the on-site inspections that were conducted over the last two days:

On August 11, 2022 PDA Inspector [REDACTED] visited [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED] in order to conduct an inspection into a possible unregistered food establishment. This facility is located on residential property and operates out of a barn-style building. PDA discovered this business during an investigation into where various jarred tomato products being sold at a farmer's market in Berks County originated. Inspector [REDACTED] met with the owner, [REDACTED], who accompanied her on the inspection. [REDACTED] was found to be illegally operating an unregistered Food Establishment that manufactured bottled wine and various jarred food products as well as operating a full service bar/retail facility. This facility lacked the proper equipment, facility and finishes to operate as a Food Establishment. It was observed that many jarred food items were produced in a make-shift outdoor kitchen with various food contact equipment observed to be stored outdoors and alongside the exterior of the building. It was also observed that wine processing occurred throughout the building, mingled

with retail space, as well as outdoors on the surrounding property. PDA Supervisor [REDACTED] joined via phone to discuss the findings with [REDACTED]

The following is a list of jarred/bottled products that were manufactured without PDA registration and offered for sale to the public:

- Various bottled wines including Hemp Infused Wine
- Pepper sauces
- Marinated Eggplant Strips
- Oyster Stuffed Olives
- San Marzano Tomato Sauce
- Dry Snack Mixes
- Pickled Beans
- Hoagie Oils
- Marinara Sauce

It was observed that this location also had a full-service bar that offers the following:

- CBD Cocktails
- Bloody Mary's
- Wine by the glass
- Bottled and canned beer products
- Various cocktails
- Food items both pre-packaged and prepared on-site.

[REDACTED] was unable to provide any proof of registration from PDA to operate as a Food Establishment at this location. He also lacked a Retail Food license through the County of Bucks local health department per Supervisor [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] agreed to voluntarily close immediately. An appointment was arranged for August 12, 2022 at 12:00pm to meet on-site along with the Bucks County Health Department. PDA provided [REDACTED] with a Food Establishment application. Inspector [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] place two signs indicating the facility was closed prior to her departure.

On August 12, 2022, [REDACTED] met with County of Bucks Health Department Supervisor [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Tinicum Township Code Enforcement Officer [REDACTED] PDA Supervisor [REDACTED] and PDA Inspector [REDACTED] to conduct an inspection to determine next steps. Per Code Enforcement Officer [REDACTED], this facility lacked local zoning approval to operate, citing deficiencies in local code such as lack of public restrooms, lack of handicap accessibility, and a building not fit for habitation and lacking emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, etc. Since Bucks County Health Department and PDA both defer to local code, they are unable to begin the process to register/license a facility without proper zoning approvals first. Bucks County officials also noted issues with the septic on-site not meeting their regulations to support the operations. [REDACTED] agreed to voluntarily cease and desist all operations moving forward, and acknowledged that if found to be operating illegally, he could be assessed citations through PDA and also Tinicum Township. He was instructed to recall any food products he was wholesaling to other Retail Food locations. [REDACTED] stated he would give the food items away or keep them for personal use only.

If the owner chooses to move operations to another location as discussed, he was instructed that he must first obtain all necessary registrations, licenses and approvals from all required entities prior to beginning operations.

Thank you to everyone for your time and collaboration today. If there is anything I left out, please let me know. Due to file-size limitations, I will forward pictures of this facility in separate emails.

You are hereby ordered to "STOP WORK." In accordance with section 403.82 of the Pa Uniform Construction Code. (Tinicum Twp Ordinance # 162)

The following conditions shall be met prior to the code official revoking the STOP WORK ORDER.

- 1) The Building Use and Occupancy was changed prior to securing building permits as required by section(s) 403.41, 403.42,(a)-(f), 403.42a Part XIV. The Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code.
You are ordered to "Stop Work" until permits are approved and issued by the Township's AHJ, (Authority having Jurisdiction).
- 2) The utility building appears to have been converted to a bar and retail store.
**You are ordered to apply for building permits per Pa Act 45.
Submit (2) sets of "sealed" construction drawings with your permit applications. Drawings shall comply with the submission requirements of the Pa Uniform Construction Code, Pa Act 45, Sections 403.42, 403.42(a), & 403.43.**

(Please note that you are required to get zoning approval from Tinicum Township prior to building permits being approved and issued.)

- 3) The building has been used and occupied without a "Certificate of Occupancy" from the Township Code Office.
You are ordered to vacate the building until a Certificate of Occupancy is issued from the Tinicum Township Code Department.
Section 403.46(a): No building or structure may be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy issued by the Building Code Official.
- 4) During the inspection on Friday, August 12, 2022, your building was deemed as an unsafe structure per the requirements of the Pa Uniform Construction Code. The building was not constructed per the requirements of the IBC for a restaurant or mercantile use.
The building does not have the required plumbing fixtures as required by the 2018 International Plumbing Code.
The building does not have the required accessible routes or accessible parking as required by the 2018 International Building Code.
There are no "Exit" signs or fire extinguishers in the building. There are no sanitary facilities for customers to use. Per the Bucks County Health Department, the current on lot septic system is only approved for a single-family dwelling use.
You are ordered to vacate the building per the Pa UCC, Act 45, Sections 403.83-403.84

Failure to comply with this order may lead to prosecution and fines per section 7210.903 of the Uniform Construction Code.

§ 7210.903. Penalties.

(a) VIOLATION OF ACT. -

(1) Any individual, firm or corporation that violates any provision of this act commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 and costs.

(2) Each day that a violation of this act continues shall be considered a separate violation.

(b) DISPOSITION OF PENALTIES. - The amount of the penalty shall be forwarded to the entity with enforcement jurisdiction.

You have the right to appeal to the UCC Appeals Board for variances or extension of time per the Pa UCC, Act 45 Section 403.122.

It was brought to this office's attention that there are three (3) non-permitted rental use (H3) exists at the Property. In accordance with section 616.1, Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code; and Article XIII, Section 1300 (h), of the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance:

THIS IS A STOP, CEASE, AND DESIST ORDER TO CORRECT ALL CONDITIONS FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE TINICUM TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO VIOLATE ANY SUCH ORDER ISSUED LAWFULLY BY THE ZONING OFFICER, AND ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY SUCH ORDER SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Specific Violations:

1. Altering and changing the use of the existing B1 with an H1 (Home Occupation Permit) without approval on the subject property, without first securing a Zoning Permit from the Zoning Officer is in violation of Section 1302 of the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance.
2. Occupying a structure which has undergone a change in use from storage building to a retail shop without first receiving a Certificate of Occupancy from the Zoning Officer is in violation of Section 1306 of the Zoning Ordinance.

EXHIBIT "F"

3. Operating an E1, E4, and E11, (Retail Store, Eating Place, and Tavern) without approval on the subject property, without first securing a Zoning Permit from the Zoning Officer is in violation of Section 1302 of the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance.
4. H7 (signs) Installing signs without first securing a Zoning Permit from the Zoning Officer is in violation of Section 1302 of the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance.

In accordance with Article XVI, Section 1602 (c) of the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance you are to commence corrections of these violations within five (5) days of this notice and correct all violations within thirty (30) days of notice. If corrections are not commenced within five (5) days or completed within thirty (30) days, each day that a violation continues shall be considered a separate offense punishable by the like fine or penalty.

You have the right to appeal this enforcement action to the Tinicum Township Zoning Hearing Board. YOU MUST FILE THIS APPEAL WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THIS NOTICE.

Failure to comply with this notice within the time specified, unless extended by appeal to the Tinicum Township Zoning Hearing Board within 30 days of this notice, constitutes a violation, and is subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 per day, pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Tinicum Township Zoning Ordinance, Article XVI.

You should take the following action immediately:

Respond to me in writing within five (5) days acknowledging this cease and desist order and stating what actions you have taken to comply with the Zoning Ordinance. If this reply in writing is not promptly received at the Tinicum Township Municipal Office, 163 Municipal Rd., Pipersville, PA 18947, or if you do not take appropriate corrective action within thirty (30) days, I shall recommend to the Township Board of Supervisors that Civil Action be filed against you with the Bucks County District Court.

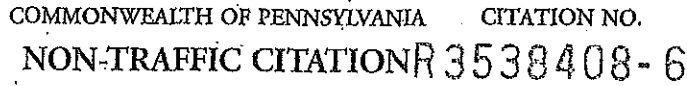
