I have a farm that I have been using since 2019 and another farm that I bought in 2021. I was cited by the township for operating a junk yard and having a building in the flood plain. As for the so called building it is actually a trailer that I store hay in and for a run-in shelter for our horses. They told me that the farm tags I bought from PennDOT do not comply with their ordinances due to no inspection, but they are exempt from inspection according to title 75 of PennDOT. Also, they told me the Farm trucks, Backhoe/loader, all rain barrels, storage barrel, tropical trees that are in containers, live traps, agricultural lime, beehives, and my black soldier fly coolers need to be inside a building. I was also told that the wild plants I planted need to be cut down. I have these plants for our bees, for our us to eat, and for medicinal uses. According to Ag law section 3, P.I. 454, No 133 and P.I. 336, No 52 I should be in the good. I have filed taxes since 2020 for my farms. Can you Please respond to me on this matter?
