My firm serves as Solicitor to Moon Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (the "Township"). Please find this letter in response to your communications regarding the Complaint filed by [REDACTED] concerning the Township's Logging Ordinance.

Please be advised that my office has reviewed the Township's Logging Ordinance, the Penn State School of Agriculture's Model Timber Harvesting Ordinance, and the Penn State publication entitled "Forest Management and Timber Harvesting in Pennsylvania – Information for Citizens and Local Government Officials" as you have suggested with the Township. As a result, the Township is currently in the process of amending the Logging Ordinance to address the issues which have been identified.
