

To Office of the Attorney General I am writing to request that your office review the actions of our local Townships. They forced me to buy a building permit to install additional Electric fencing to contain my Scotch Highland Cattle on our Century Farm in Foster Twp in Luzerne County.

They ([REDACTED]) insisted I put all my wire fencing on the out perimeter of the fenceposts. All fencing Contractors I contacted and spoke to say the wire fence belongs on the inside except on inside the corners or curves. The Cattle can push on the wire and there by pop the staples out of the posts. Even when electrified a older + wiser animal will shove a young + dumb animal thru the fence making it ineffective.

I bought the permit to keep peace with local govt. approx a year ago. When the permit was issued I decided I would not comply with the Ass backward fence requirement.

The Ken Cowl fence Manual say only corner + curve fencing should be done on the outside.
