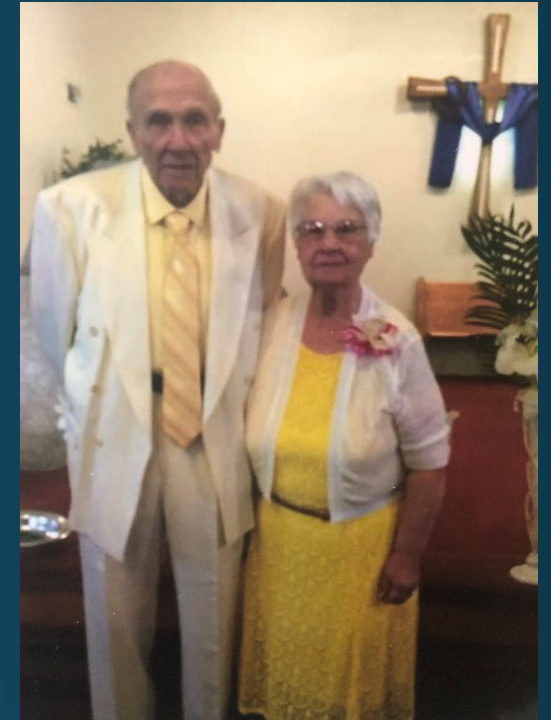

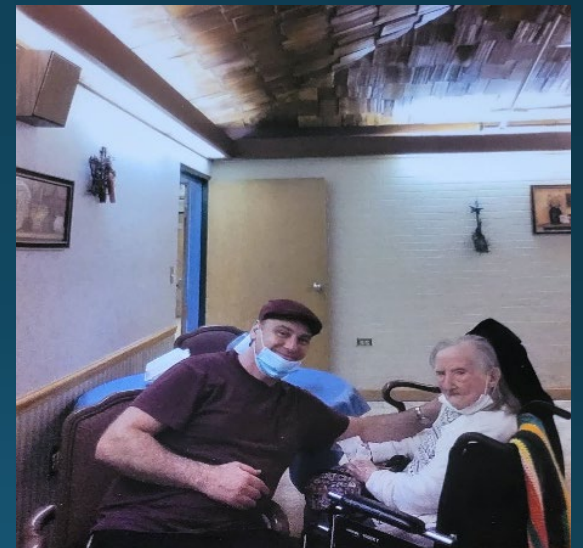
Betty Hutchison

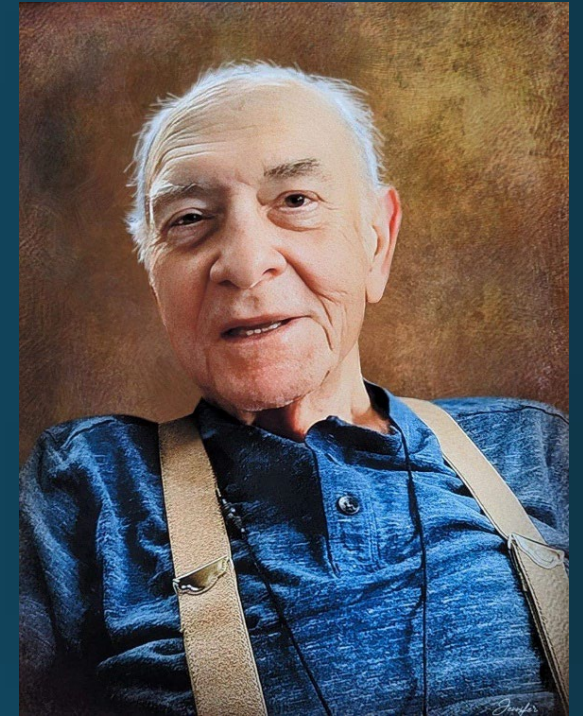
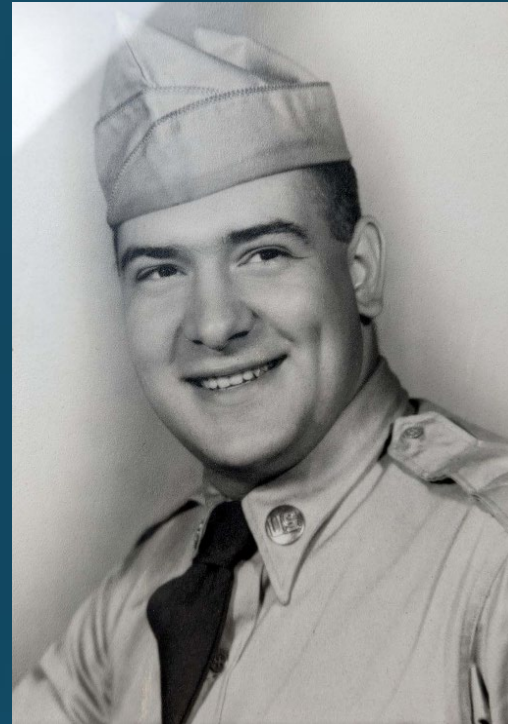

- Achieved his lifelong goal of obtaining his pilot's license and loved to fly whenever he could



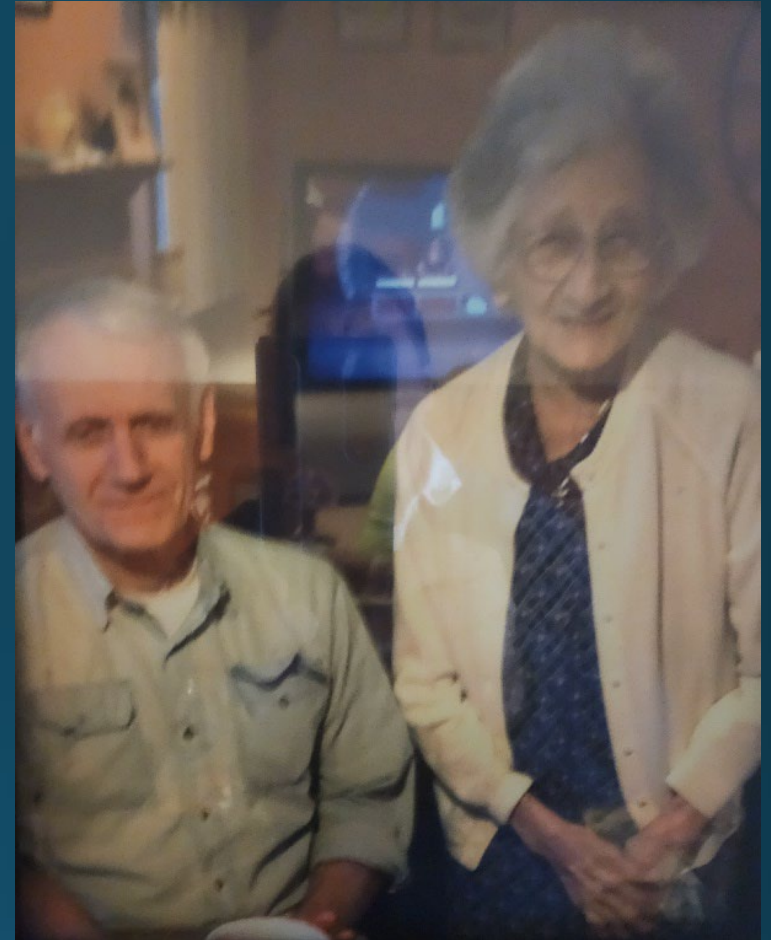
Irene Simons

- Worked at Penreco for over 40 years as a pipefitter before retiring

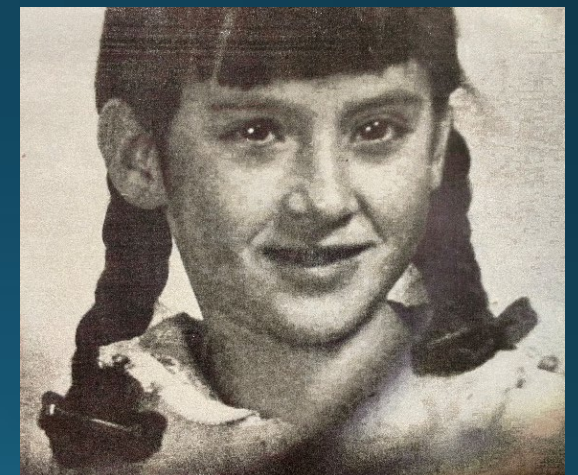


Louise Skinner

- Resident of Belair Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center

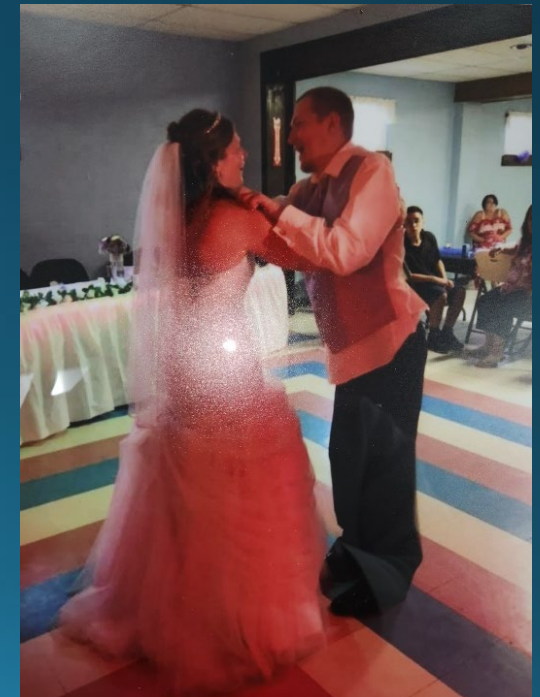
Mary Colwell
