Attn. A.C.R.E. Review:

Please, accept this <u>Emergency</u> Request, for your Review. While I understand, that A.C.R.E., cannot override an ongoing, Agricultural, Court of Common Pleas, dispute. I've taken the liberty, of enclosing my Complaint, as a Berks County Resident, <u>Docket No. 25-10052</u>, for your <u>close</u> review. I also understand, that NONE of the Commonwealth's, 2,600 Municipalities, can override A.C.R.E. Act 38, in changing Agricultural Zoning. In this case, from a 273 year old <u>Farming District</u>, -to-<u>Industrial</u>, by their illegal Overlays, in <u>South Heidelberg Township</u>, <u>Berks County</u>, <u>Pa.</u>, without first, getting, the "<u>express permission</u>", <u>from A.C.R.E. 38</u>. As you will note, in the <u>Complaint</u>, <u>there are 5 Commonwealth</u>, <u>Agricultural Laws</u>, <u>being overridden</u>. A <u>letter</u> to South Heidelberg Township's Manager, at advising him, that the Township, <u>does not have the State's Permission</u>, to change the Agricultural Zoning, to <u>INDUSTRIAL</u>, would be greatly appreciated.
